Pensacola, FL — One parish in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee has sustained damage from Hurricane Idalia. Immaculate Conception in Perry was hit hard as the storm moved through Wednesday morning. The church sustained structural damage and multiple trees fell on the parish hall, the rectory, and the office. Over the coming days, assessments will be done to determine the best way to proceed to repair the damage.

Unfortunately, many people in the community lost their homes to flooding and hurricane force winds.
