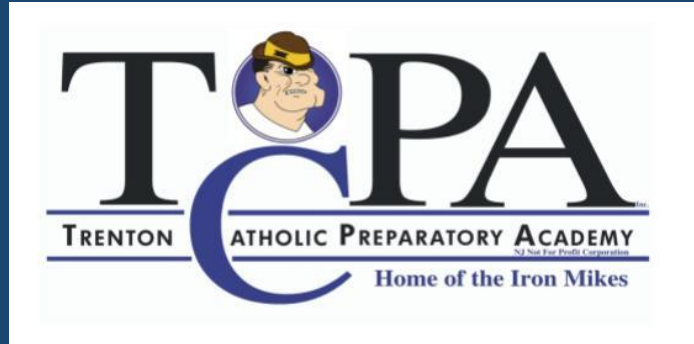

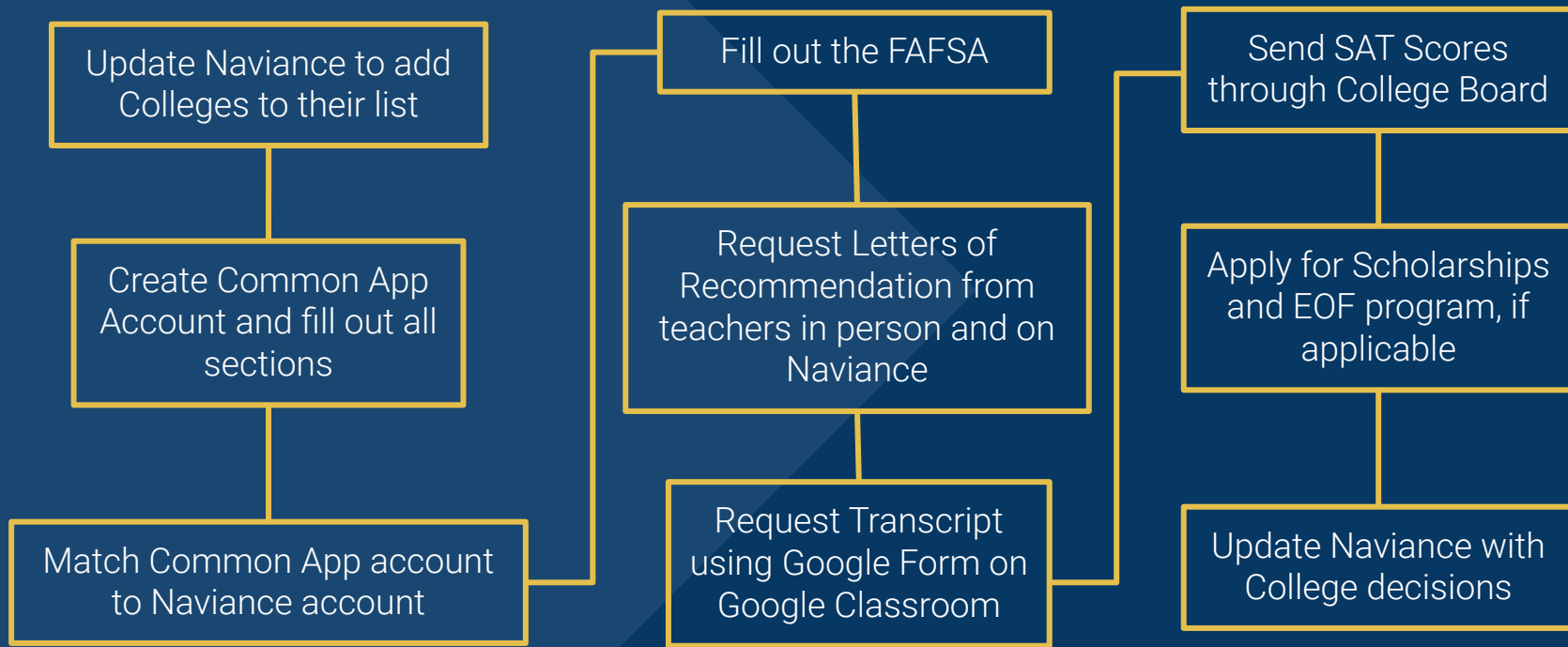

- ❑ October 5th - NHS Ceremony for New Inductees
- ❑ November 8th - College and Career Fair

- ❑ December - FAFSA Opens (this year only)
- ❑ May 1st - National Decision Day
- ❑ May 10th - Senior Retreat\*

# College Visits

- ❑ Schedule a campus tour
  - ❑ Weekday campus tours are an excused absence with note
- ❑ Attend an open house
  - ❑ Typically on weekends
  - ❑ Register through College's website
- ❑ College and Career Fair November 8th
- ❑ Shows Demonstrated Interest to College
  - ❑ Considered during application review by admissions representatives



# Admission Types

01

## Early Action

- ❑ Deadline typically November 1st or 15th
- ❑ Receive a response quicker
- ❑ Non-Binding

02

## Early Decision

- ❑ Deadline typically November 1st or 15th
- ❑ **Binding** Agreement
- ❑ Must attend the school if accepted

03

## Regular Decision

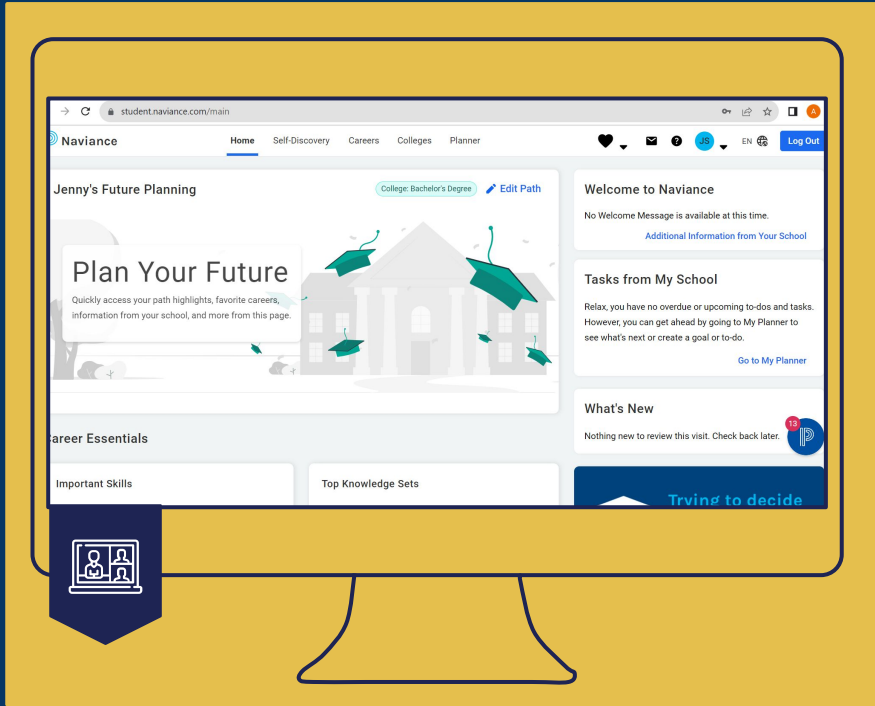
- ❑ Typically between January and February
- ❑ Responses take longer
- ❑ Non-Binding

04

## Rolling Admission

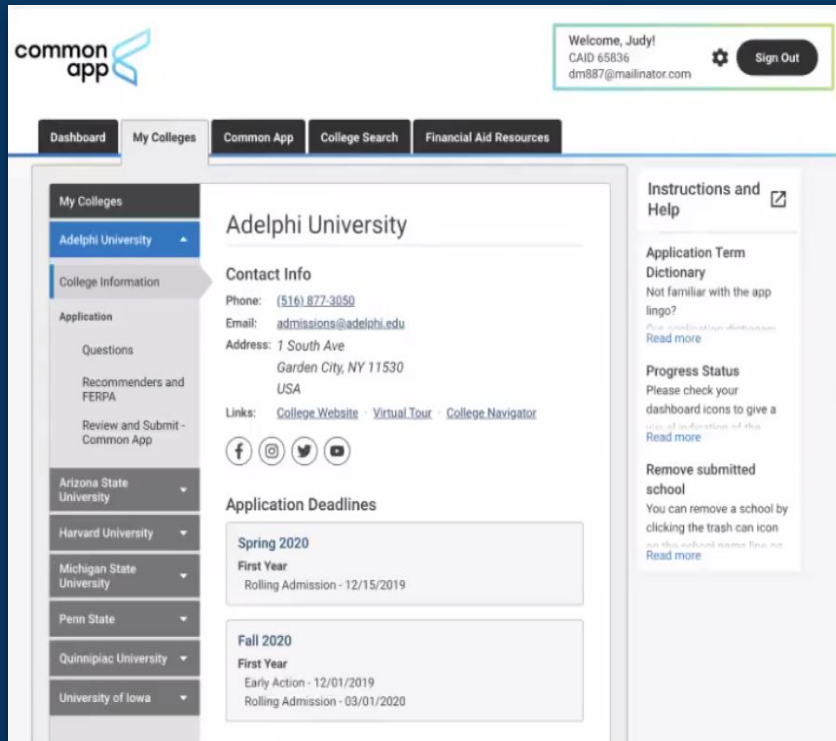
- ❑ Can apply on a rolling bases - no deadline
- ❑ Receive a response as soon as admissions review application
- ❑ Non-Binding

# Naviance



- ❑ Resource for students to plan for post-secondary options
- ❑ Browse colleges, take interest and skills inventories, update their application status
- ❑ Link with Common App so I can send school, teacher, and counselor documents
  - ❑ Letters of Recommendation
  - ❑ Transcripts
  - ❑ School Reports
- ❑ Must complete Brag Sheet on Class of 2024 Google Classroom for my letter
- ❑ Parents/guardians must sign record release form in packet

# Common Application



- ❑ Application platform accepted by most colleges
- ❑ Fill out personal and academic information once and send to multiple colleges
- ❑ Separate set of questions for each college
- ❑ Links to Naviance
  - ❑ Where transcripts, school reports, and letters of recommendation are sent through
- ❑ Sign FERPA Waiver
  - ❑ Allows for academic information to be shared, such as transcripts
- ❑ Fee Waiver for students who are eligible
- ❑ Do not request letters of recommendation through Common App



# Mercer County Community College



- ❑ Can complete courses towards an Associate's Degree or transfer credits to another institution
- ❑ Affordable option for completing standard courses before moving on to 4-year institution
- ❑ Many grants and scholarships for MCCC as well as for students who attend a 4-year institution after completing associates at Mercer
- ❑ Apply right through their website - no Common App required
- ❑ This applies to all Community Colleges in New Jersey, not just Mercer

# College Board & SATs

- ❑ Upcoming SAT dates:
  - ❑ October 7
  - ❑ November 4
  - ❑ December 2
  - ❑ March 9 - Digital
  - ❑ May 4 - Digital
  - ❑ June 1 - Digital
- ❑ Many colleges are still test optional
  - ❑ Only send them if you believe they will be beneficial to application
- ❑ SAT practice and preparation available through Khan Academy
- ❑ BigFuture College Planning Tools
  - ❑ College Search
  - ❑ Scholarship Search
  - ❑ Explore Careers and take quizzes

# Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- ❑ Commonly known as the FAFSA
- ❑ Typically opens October 1st, delayed this year until December
- ❑ FREE Application that determines your child's eligibility for loans, grants, scholarships, work study, and aid for military families
- ❑ Subsidized Loans
  - ❑ Government pays the interest
  - ❑ Based on financial need
- ❑ Unsubsidized Loans
  - ❑ Interest paid by borrower
  - ❑ Not based on financial need
- ❑ Grants and Scholarships
  - ❑ Typically do not have to be paid back
  - ❑ Based on merit, talent, area of study, etc.
- ❑ Work Study Jobs
  - ❑ Student can earn money to pay for school by working at least half-time
  - ❑ Jobs typically on campus - front desk jobs, cafeteria, dorms, etc.
- ❑ Apply by school's deadline or June 30th at the latest
- ❑ Start repaying loans after graduation



# Scholarships



- ❑ Can be given to students from colleges they apply to
  - ❑ Colleges use FAFSA information to provide need-based scholarships
  - ❑ Many offer merit-based scholarships based on student's GPA and coursework
- ❑ Find independent scholarships
  - ❑ Community or culturally based
- ❑ BigFuture Scholarship Search on College Board
  - ❑ Win scholarships by completing tasks on College Board's site
  - ❑ Scholarship Directory
  - ❑ Additional Scholarship Partners
- ❑ RaiseMe micro-scholarships
- ❑ Going Merry Scholarships

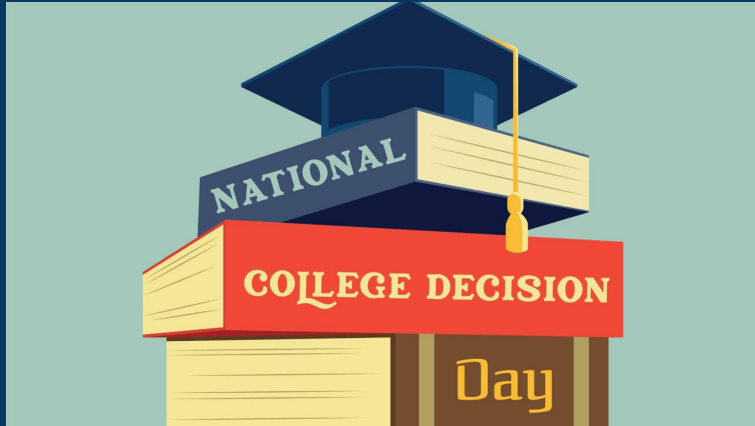
# Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)

- ❑ New Jersey Program that provides financial assistance and support services to students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds
- ❑ Have to meet certain criteria\*
  - ❑ NJ criteria as well as individual college
- ❑ Limited number of spots at each college
- ❑ Student can apply for program by checking the EOF box while filling out the Common App
- ❑ FAFSA has to be submitted for college to receive financial information
- ❑ Offered at Kean, Montclair, NJIT, Rowan, Rutgers, TCNJ, Stockton, Ramapo, William Paterson, Mercer County Community College, Seton Hall, Stevens, Monmouth, Rider, Georgian Court, Felician, and more

# National Decision Day



- ❑ May 1, 2024
- ❑ National deadline for responding to College acceptances and registering to become a student at desired College
- ❑ Day to celebrate!!!!
- ❑ Schools with rolling admissions will have their own acceptance deadlines
- ❑ Remind students we will send mid-year and final grades
  - ❑ Failing a class can result in a college rescinding their acceptance
  - ❑ Avoid Senioritis!!
