If this is your first child, you will also need to plan on attending a Pre-Baptismal class which takes place on a bi-monthly basis. Baptism is not celebrated during Lent.

We, the parish community of St. Catharine, are dedicated to spreading the Good News by word and example. Welcome Back!!

We are so happy to welcome you back and to begin the process of worshipping together in person. In order to be able to do so, we are required by the Archdiocese to adhere to strict guidelines in accordance with national, state, and local directives. Those directives are outlined on page 5. We ask that everyone please adhere to them without exception so that we can continue to keep the church open.

In addition we have put the following processes in place to ensure everyone's safety:

- Trained Monitors will be at every Mass to assist with our new processes.
- We will be seating people as they enter and we ask everyone to please take the seat in which they are assigned.
- We need this process to be timely, orderly and safe.
- Entrance will be through the Main Doors or Bell Tower ONLY.
- The gym entrance will be locked at all times and access to the church through Community Hall will be restricted.
- We also ask that you try to use the facilities at home prior to leaving for church. Bathrooms will be open, but we hope that they will be for urgent or emergent use only and use will be limited to 2 persons at a time. Parents must accompany children to the bathroom.

As much as we want everything to be back to the way things were, it is just not possible at this point. With that being said, it is important to note that once the church is at capacity, we will not be able to admit anyone else. While we recognize that it may be an inconvenience in the short term, it is what needs to be done in order to follow the regulations and remain open. There will be signs outside of the church to indicate if we have reached capacity.

Cardinal Tobin has continued the dispensation from the Sunday obligation. If you are an at-risk person, have been exposed to the virus, or are feeling ill in any way, we ask that you please stay home. Mass will continue to be livestreamed at 5:30PM on Saturdays, with archived viewing at any time.

There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the Coronavirus. Improved cleaning will occur at (our) Church, but one should not expect that they will be safer from germs than in other public spaces.

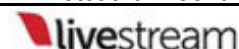

Today's Readings

There is a good reason that the writings of St. Paul don't show up as examples in grammar textbooks. Today's reading is a case in point. It begins with one of those long Pauline run on sentences that leave lectors gasping for breath. So what? Take a closer look at how Paul's fervor for his subject matter derails the grammar. There is something admirable about being so caught up in his convictions that the words cannot come fast enough to express them, much less in an orderly fashion. Scripture scholars usually take this grammatical ineptness as a sign of a passage's early importance in the Christian community, something they were so ardent about that their language never got refined.

What leaves us in this condition? Re-telling the plot line of an action movie or the play-by-play of a sporting event? When was the last time any of us was so excited by our faith in Christ that we were left grasping for words, stumbling over our own errors in speech? It may be bad grammar, but it is an excellent way to inspire others with the message of Christ! Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

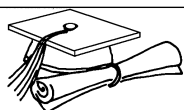
Stay Connected!

We need the cooperation of every person who chooses to attend Mass in the Church.

Please also read page 5 for more information.

The following must be adhered to at all times:

- If you are ill in any way, please stay at home until you are well.
- If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone who has COVID-19 please stay home until you have completed the recommended quarantine period (14 days for those exposed OR 14 days past the last display of symptoms for those diagnosed).
- Masks must be worn at all times once you enter the building. We do not have a supply and everyone should have their own mask by this time.
- You may choose to wear gloves. There will also be hand sanitizer available at the entrance to building in the Narthex and near the restrooms.
- Avoid touching any and all surfaces as much as possible.
- Everyone must access the Church by the main entrance. If you require the ramp you may use the bell tower entrance. The gym entrance will be closed.
- Social distancing remains in force. Taped off areas must be avoided.
- It may become necessary to limit the number of visitors in the Church at any given time.
- All of the above will be enforced by a designated monitor, either a staff person or volunteer. Please respect their requests as they have a job to do.

Welcome Back!

Directives for Attending Mass:

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Please stay home if you are ill, showing signs of illness or have been exposed to anyone with the virus. Cardinal Tobin has given a dispensation from the obligation to attend mass.

- Please arrive 15 minutes (no earlier than 20mins) prior to the start of mass.
- Please do not gather in the parking lot or on the church steps.
- Please have your mask on when outside of your vehicle. You will not be permitted into the church without a mask.
- Please enter thru the main doors or the Bell Tower and proceed directly to the Narthex.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- You will be welcomed by a monitor who will escort you to a seat.
- You will be seated from front to back in the church to allow for maximum occupancy and appropriate social distancing.
- You will be seated in Community Hall after the main church is full.
- You must keep your mask on at all times.
NO EXCEPTIONS.

DURING THE MASS

- Please maintain social distancing at all times.
- Please remember that this is new for all of us. There will be adjustments that need to be made.
- Please place your weekly offering in the basket as you leave the church. There will not be a physical collection taken up. If you have not been using Faith Direct – this is the perfect opportunity to prayerfully consider doing so.
- Please do not have any physical contact during the “Sign of Peace”. A simple nod or wave will suffice.
- Please follow the Monitors instructions for exiting the church. We will dismiss by rows.
- Please do not gather on the church steps or in the parking lot after mass.
- Please join us again for worship.
- Please limit bathroom use to urgent need only.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

- Monitors will exit each row into the center aisle
- If waiting online, please stand on the blue tape to ensure social distancing.
- Only the Precious Body will be distributed and it MUST be received on the hand.
- When you approach the Minister, please have hands extended, one over the other.
- Allow the Minister to place the Precious Body in your hand – do not reach for it or take it from the Minister
- Step to the side, place the Eucharist in your mouth, readjust your mask if necessary
- Return to your seat via the side aisle
- If you are NOT receiving, please come forward anyway, cross your hands over your chest and stay in line with others in your row.

WHAT ARE WE DOING TO KEEP EVERYONE SAFE

- All printed material has been removed from the church.
- All Holy Water dips and the font have been drained and will remain empty.
- The church is cleaned and disinfected in between each mass and regularly during the week.
- Bathrooms are cleaned and disinfected in between each mass and regularly during the week.
- Door handles and other touch points are disinfected in between each mass and regularly during the week.
- Hand sanitizers are located throughout the building.
- Entrance has been limited to the Main Doors and the Bell Tower.
- Mask use is strictly enforced.
- Social Distancing measures are in place and will be enforced.

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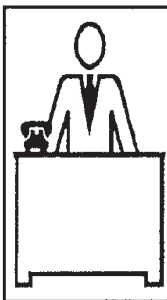


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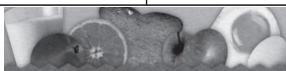
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
