You were buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. — Colossians 2:12

Today's Readings

Reading I: Genesis 18: 20-32 After God announces His plan, a dialogue follows between Him and Abraham, in which Abraham is a bargainer. He makes daring proposals to God, but along the way he models persistence in prayer.

Reading II: Colossians 2: 12-14 Paul instructs the community of the fact that by their union with Christ, there is forgiveness of sin. This in turn is connected with their baptism, in which they died and rose with Christ.

The Gospel: Luke 11: 1-13 Jesus provides a catechism on prayer which stresses persistence as an essential component. This is particularly difficult for First World citizens, surrounded by a glut of "time saving" gadgets.


