A strongly rooted mulberry tree can be uprooted by our faith. Our works of love and service are the best response to this gift of Faith.

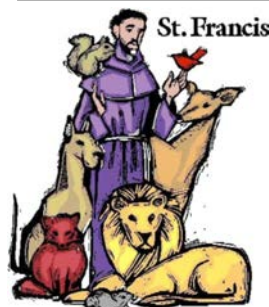

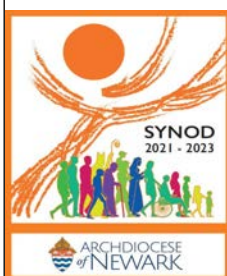

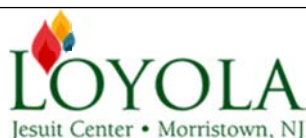
