Today's Readings

Reading I: Acts 10:34a, 37-43 St. Peter's sermon amounts to a summary of Jesus' earthly life, followed by the definite proclamation that "this man God raised on the third day." He will be the judge of everyone.

Reading II: Colossians 3:1-4 St. Paul's reference to Christ as "seated at the right hand of God" was often used in the early church to point out how the Old Testament promises about the coming Messiah had been fulfilled.

The Gospel: John 20:1-9 John not only describes here the miracle of "the first day of the week" but also insists that Jesus "had to rise from the dead." The very core of our faith.


