

# Fourth Sunday of Easter

### Today's Readings

**Reading I: Acts 2:14a, 36-41** After proclaiming Jesus as Lord and Christ, Peter calls for his audience to repent and be baptized. Their question is answered. The number 3,000 converts is historically implausible, but gets used to show the success of the Pentecost mission as wrought by the Holy Spirit.

**Reading II: I Peter 2: 20b-25** The author (not St. Peter himself) includes an early Christina hymn which stresses that Jesus' wounds heal us and bring us to the true shepherd.

**The Gospel: John 10: 1-10** Jesus claims to be both the gate and the shepherd of the true flock. His parable is meant to reveal who He is. The term "good" here means "an ideal or model."


