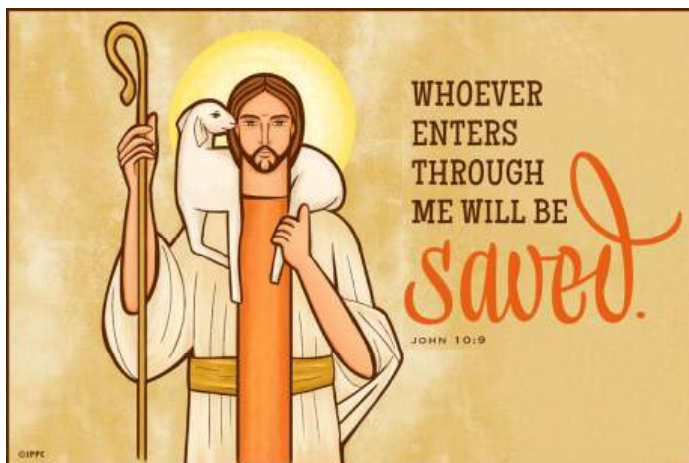

Fourth Sunday of Easter

Today's Readings

Reading I: Acts 2:14a, 36-41 After proclaiming Jesus as Lord and Christ, Peter calls for his audience to repent and be baptized. Their question is answered. The number 3,000 converts is historically implausible, but gets used to show the success of the Pentecost mission as wrought by the Holy Spirit.

Reading II: 1 Peter 2: 20b-25 The author (not St. Peter himself) includes an early Christian hymn which stresses that Jesus' wounds heal us and bring us to the true shepherd.

The Gospel: John 10: 1-10 Jesus claims to be both the gate and the shepherd of the true flock. His parable is meant to reveal who He is. The term "good" here means "an ideal or model."

Congratulations to RCIA Candidates, Robert Fabbri and Christopher Park who completed their Sacraments of Initiation at St. Catharine on April 16th. Robert received the Sacrament of Confirmation and Christopher received the Sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation.

Each of us has our own journey of faith. Our Catholic faith provides a rich and beautiful means to draw us into a deeper relationship with our Lord. Perhaps you or someone you know has not received all the Sacraments of Initiation (that is, Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation). Perhaps you may have questions about how our Catholic faith differs from other faith traditions. About what it means to be a Catholic. About how to enter into the Catholic faith more fully.



The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

is a process to explore these and other questions as well as enter more fully into the Catholic faith. It is often called a journey of faith in which we welcome others to the Catholic family. It is a program for those who have never been baptized, were baptized in other faith traditions, or were baptized in the Catholic faith but never completed the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist, or Confirmation.

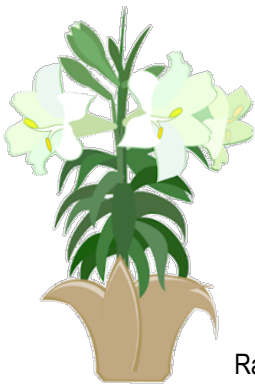

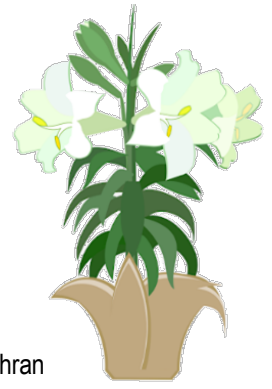

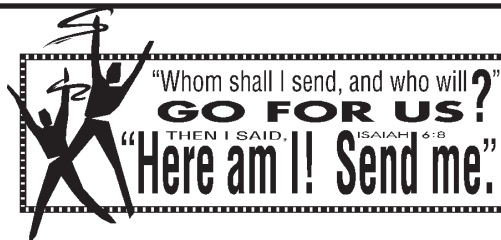
