Special Note Regarding Ascension



In 2022, the Bishops of New Jersey, following the earlier lead of most of the dioceses in the US, permanently moved the liturgical celebration of the **Ascension of the Lord**, from the 40th day after Easter, to the 7th Sunday of Easter. This effectively reduces the number of Holydays of Obligation from six, the number decided upon in 1791, to five. **As such, we celebrate the Solemnity this Sunday, May 21** and will follow suit on the respective

Sundays each year hereafter.

The Solemnity of the Ascension was traditionally celebrated each year on a Thursday, on a particular date related to the date on which Easter is celebrated. As you know, the Ascension of the Lord recognizes and celebrates Jesus' Ascension back to Heaven, after His Resurrection from the Dead, and Earthly appearances to His Disciples.

- 3) Complete **Criminal Background Check** (facilitated by rectory)

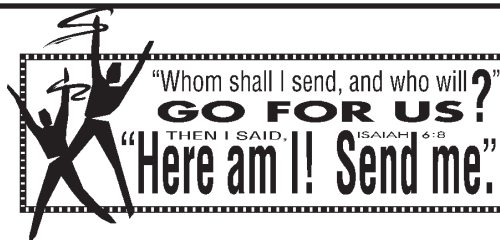
