Today's Readings

Reading I: Ezekiel 33:7-9 The prophet is assigned the duty from the Lord to act as a watchman over Israel. As Babylon is about to destroy Jerusalem, his warning about trying to turn a wicked person to change his ways is crucial.

Reading II: Romans 13:8-10 St. Paul turns to the Christian's obligation of neighborly love both as a summary of the Law of Moses and that of Christ on the subject.

The Gospel: Matthew 18:15-20 Jesus gives us two different insights. The first is a three step procedure to follow when someone offends us, with the personal one on one ranked first. The second insight is the powerful and consoling truth that He is in the midst of any gathering formed in His name.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Each of us has our own journey of faith. Our Catholic faith provides a rich and beautiful means to draw us into a deeper relationship with our Lord. Perhaps you or someone you know has not received all the Sacraments of Initiation (that is, Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation). Perhaps you may have questions about how our Catholic faith differs from other faith traditions. About what it means to be a Catholic. About how to enter into the Catholic faith more fully.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process to explore these and other questions as well as enter more fully into the Catholic faith. It is RATA often called a journey of faith in which we welcome others to the Catholic family. It is a program

for those who have never been baptized, were baptized in other faith traditions, or were baptized in the Catholic faith but never completed the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist, or Confirmation.

If you or someone you know wants to learn more about this journey, we will be hosting an RCIA Information Session this Tuesday, September 12th at 7:30 PM in the Ministry Center (1st floor meeting room).
