### **VIRTUS Safe Environment Policy**

Compliance of the Archdiocese of Newark's Safe Environment Policy is required for all volunteers and employees (18 years/older) who work/volunteer with children in our parish or at Academy of Our Lady. This includes all CCD teachers & aides, CYO chaperones, AoOL classroom, lunch & library volunteers, class parents, HSA members, coaches, Scout leaders, etc.

**Safe Environment Policy requirements include:**

- 1) Attend a **Protecting God's Children Workshop**  
See below (recertification of PGC is required every 5yrs)
- 2) Complete a **Volunteer Application** and **Archdiocesan Code of Conduct**
- 3) Complete **Criminal Background Check** (facilitated by rectory)
