Second Sunday of Advent

Today's Readings

Reading I: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11 In the prophet's vision, The Lord addresses a heavenly assembly that includes himself. Someone speaks up and says that the Lord will soon lead a new exodus through the desert.

Reading II: 2 Peter 3:8-14 The author addresses any cynics who scoff at God's seeming delay in coming. This time actually allows for necessary repentance. Still, the day of His coming remains unknowable.

The Gospel: Mark 1:1-8 Mark relates the promise of the Old Testament prophets to John the Baptist, and also to his divine Cousin Jesus who actually is "the One to come," the Messiah.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Parishioners,

Back in ancient times when a king planned to visit a certain town, he sent an "advance man" ahead of him. Because few ancient roads were paved with gravel or stone, the advance man would have the people fill up mud holes and straighten out the paths. Another thing the advance man did was instruct the people in the proper protocol for receiving the king.

In the season of Advent, the Church is the advance man. It focuses our attention on Jesus. It tells us Jesus is coming and discusses how to prepare for Him.

In today's gospel, John the Baptist was Jesus' advance man. He saw that the roads were prepared and told the people to be kind to one another, just as Jesus teaches us.

As we prepare to celebrate Jesus' coming, we too want to follow Jesus' teaching of kindness to one another. Along with preparing to celebrate Jesus' birth, we're also preparing for Jesus' second coming, when we receive our final judgement.

So let's see the church as Jesus' advance man. In our kindness to one another, we are following Jesus' message of love. Then we will be preparing to celebrate Jesus' birth at Christmas. We will also be preparing for his second coming at the end of time.

Sanctus Bells



Last weekend we brought back the practice of ringing the Sanctus Bells during the consecration. This practice is used to call attention to the precise moment when transubstantiation, the conversion of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, takes place. The bells are first rung prior to the consecration at the "epiclesis" - when the Holy Spirit is called down to change the gifts of bread and wine into the Body, Blood, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. The bells are rung a second and third time at the elevation and presentation of the Body and Blood of Christ. The fourth and final ring happens after the Priest has consumed the Body and Blood. This final ring also serves as an invitation for all to come forward and receive the Eucharist.

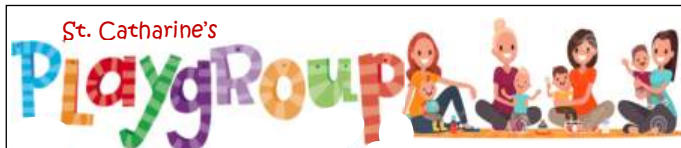
