**Reader -** The response to each petition is "Lord, hear our prayer".

#### Reader -

- 1. For N.\*\* who in baptism was given the pledge of eternal life, that he/she\*\* now be admitted to the company of the saints, we pray together in faith...
- 2. For our brother/sister\*\* who ate the body of Christ, the bread of life, that he/she\*\* may be raised up on the last day, we pray together in faith...
- 3. For the family and friends of our brother/sister\*\* N.\*\*, that they may be consoled in their grief by the Lord who wept at the death of his friend Lazarus, we pray together in faith...
- 4. For our deceased relatives and friends and for all who have helped us, that they may have the reward of their goodness, we pray together in faith...
- 5. For those who have fallen asleep in the hope of rising again, that they may see God face to face, we pray together in faith...
- 6. For all of us assembled here to worship in faith, that we may be gathered together again in God's kingdom, we pray together in faith...

#### Priest -

God, our shelter and our strength, you listen in love to the cry of your people: hear the prayers we offer for our departed brothers and sisters. Cleanse them of their sins and grant them the fullness of redemption. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
