**Quality Time: Martha & Mary**

Luke 10:38-42

Martha and Mary- both good people. Both love God. Both are friends of Jesus Christ. Martha is busy about many things. Mary just wants to sit at the feet of Jesus and hang on his every word. Ironically, Mary sets the better example.

It's not that work is bad. Work is necessary and good. But it should not be an idol. If you are busy, busy, busy all the time- what are you trying to avoid? What is stopping you from going to the Church to just spend some quality time in prayer? What is stopping you from spending quality time with your husband, wife, children, grandparents? We are human *beings* not human *doings*.

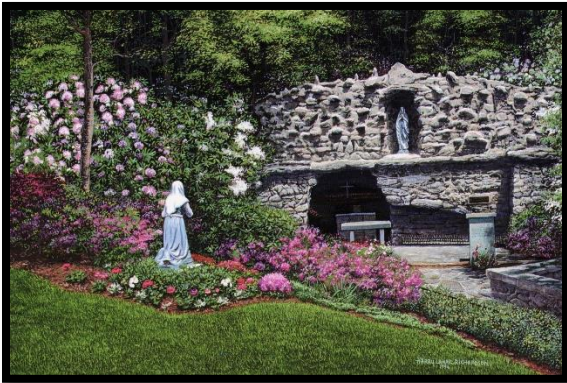

The Fifteenth Day of August:  
an important day for our parish  
because on this day...

- No later than 602 AD, this day is set aside to commemorate Mary’s entrance into Heaven in the Christian Byzantine Empire
- No later than 700 AD, this feast is well established and celebrated in Rome and elsewhere in Western Christendom
- In 1534 AD, the “Society of Jesus” was founded by Saint Ignatius Loyola, Saint Francis Xavier and five other men. Members of the Society are called “Jesuits” and our parish began as a mission church of the Jesuits
- In 1851- Archbishop Francis Kenrick of Philadelphia consecrated our church. The original Conewago Chapel was named in honor of the Assumption- hence the prominence of the Assumption image in the nave of our church
- In 1947, India achieved independence from Great Britain. (Our own *Deacon*- soon to be *Father*- Norbert Suresh is from India.)
- In 2012, the day that Monsignor George Rost died. He had served as the pastor of the Basilica from 1980-2000.
