Update on Interior Restoration Project

The plans for the interior restoration are underway. The first phase will involve work in the vestibule and on a mock-up in one of the transepts. Here is a tentative timeline:

- Sept 6 - Installation of scaffolding begins in one transept to begin the mock-up
- Sept 8 – Painting on mock-up begins
- Sept 12 – Work in the vestibule begins
- Sept 21 – Scaffolding comes down, mock up complete before a wedding on Sept 24
- Work on the vestibule continues into October

The second phase of the project will involve restoration of the front of the church. On October 17 the installation of the scaffolding in the sanctuary and the two transepts begins. It takes at least one week to install.

- Goal 1: To get as much in the very front done by Christmas
- Goal 2: Complete entire front of the church (including transepts' ceilings and walls but not including the oculus) by Palm Sunday 2023
- Before Palm Sunday – All scaffolding removed for Holy Week.

At this point, we have received enough monies to fund these first two phases of the project. The final phase – the restoration of the nave – will begin after Easter and should be complete by August 2023. Please continue to support this project prayerfully and financially. May God abundantly bless this effort!

Walk with Jesus Wednesdays for upcoming K-4th grade STC students!





**The Fifteenth Day of August:
an important day for our parish
because on this day...**

- No later than [602 AD](#), this day is set aside to commemorate Mary's entrance into Heaven in the Christian Byzantine Empire
- No later than [700 AD](#), this feast is well established and celebrated in Rome and elsewhere in Western Christendom
- In [1534 AD](#), the "Society of Jesus" was founded by Saint Ignatius Loyola, Saint Francis Xavier and five other men. Members of the Society are called "Jesuits" and our parish began as a mission church of the Jesuits
- In [1851](#)- Archbishop Francis Kenrick of Philadelphia consecrated our church. The original Conewago Chapel was named in honor of the Assumption- hence the prominence of the Assumption image in the nave of our church
- In [1947](#), India achieved independence from Great Britain. (Our own Deacon- soon to be Father- Norbert Suresh is from India.)
- In [2012](#), the day that Monsignor George Rost died. He had served as the pastor of the Basilica from 1980-2000.


