

## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING MARCH 16. 2023

Members in attendance were: Fr. Schlaline, Larry Raville, Bridget Wurtz, Sue Riser, Jim Rosner and Chuck Minchik.

- The restoration project was discussed. The scaffolding will move from the front of the church to the back beginning on March 27. There may be a need to have Palm Sunday Mass in the gym depending on how many pews are taken up with the scaffolding move. The entire project will conclude with a 5pm Mass followed by a banquet on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Bishop Gainer will preside. We may be receiving two additional grants from the Vulcan and Raskob Foundations.
- There will be future announcements to gain more volunteers to bring up the offertory for the 7:30 Mass. We will also look into adding them to the software program we use for lectors and altar servers beginning in August when the new schedule is completed.
- We are hosting a parish breakfast on May 13<sup>th</sup> with a presentation on Our Lady of Fatima. Also, we may have coffee after Masses on the front lawn this spring when the weather cooperates. Volunteers will be needed.
- The HVAC system for the gym will be replaced this summer.
- STC is looking to fill a vacancy for a part-time music teacher. Delone is looking for part-time cafeteria help.
- The next Parish Council meeting is scheduled for May 4<sup>th</sup>.
