Parish Faith Formation: Lourdes and the Miraculous Cures

Sunday August 6 7:00 pm In the parish gym

☞ This multimedia presentation reviews the history of the Blessed Virgin Mary’s apparitions at Lourdes, France and highlights some of the miraculous cures attributed to Our Lady’s intercession. It will be given by Steve Hemler, President of the Catholic Apologetics Institute of North America (CAINA) and author of a trilogy of published apologetics books. Many of his ancestors attended Conewago Chapel and are buried here. This presentation briefly reviews the history of the extraordinary appearances of the Virgin Mary to 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes in 1858. We also will explore several of the thousands of cures that have taken place in Lourdes, including recent ones that defy explanation by even the most skeptical medical personnel using the best modern technology.
