#### **Ember Days**

Centuries ago, the Church set aside three days near the beginning of each season to thank God for the blessings of that season -particularly for the wheat, grapes and olives used in the sacraments. These days were also set apart to pray for priests, especially the newly ordained, since ordinations were held during Ember Days at that time. The next Ember Days are after Pentecost on June 11, 13, and 15. This can be a great time to pray and offer sacrifices for vocations to the priesthood. Here is a prayer you might use:
