### Our Preacher for Forty Hours: Archbishop Timothy Broglio



Archbishop Broglio grew up in an active Catholic family, just a little over a block from his parish church in Cleveland Heights, Ohio. He said that, as he grew up, he "was attracted to what he saw the priest doing." By the end of high school, through prayer, Eucharistic adoration, and talking

to priests and others he trusted, he became convinced that the Lord was calling him to be a diocesan priest. During college, he attended daily Mass, and he made sure to take the courses he would need to get into the seminary. He was sent to the North American College in Rome, where he was ordained a priest in 1977. His first priestly assignment was at a parish 20 minutes from his home in Ohio, where he served as associate pastor, and lectured in theology at a Catholic college near his parish. After two short years, he was sent back to Rome to complete his degree. There, he was invited to join the Pontifical Ecclesiastical Academy, to prepare for diplomatic service for the church. From 1983 to 2007, he served in international positions in the Ivory Coast, Paraguay, and Central America. In 2007, Pope Saint John Paul II appointed him Archbishop of the Military Services, U.S.A. His almost world-wide archdiocese includes all active military and their families, all Catholics in VA hospitals, and all Catholics who work for the U.S. government outside the U.S. Archbishop Broglio describes his life as a priest as "a wonderful way to serve the Lord in serenity and peace." He reminds those considering the priesthood that the Lord manifests His will through interests, capabilities, and people that He might put in their path. In addition to caring for his very large congregation (over a million people), Archbishop Broglio's other duties include serving as Chancellor of Catholic International University, member of the Board of Directors for the National Catholic Bioethics Center, and current president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). We express our deep gratitude to Archbishop Broglio for coming to preach our 40 Hours services, and we welcome him. 


