## New Year, New Projects

Sacred Heart Basilica has been a historic landmark for a long time. Regularly, there are groups of pilgrims who come for visits and tours. At times, our parish is asked whether there is a gift shop, a museum, and/or a place to eat lunch. In the next few months, we will begin a renovation of the parish’s barn. The barn will be a cozy space for meetings and will have a small museum, gift shop and restrooms. We have many artifacts and items to put on display. Our incredible legacy of faith, hope and love deserves such a space dedicated to sharing our story. This project has been approved by the diocese and costs \$845,085. One generous parishioner has already pledged to cover half of the cost. We invite you also to consider supporting this valiant effort.

A month ago, our parish applied for a grant from the same foundation that had awarded us a large grant for the Interior Restoration Project a few years ago. We were just notified this week that our application for a grant has been denied. There are some other foundations that we are looking at as well.


In light of that, uncertainty remains about what should be done with the Saint Joseph Convent. Our attempts to welcome another group of religious sisters have not panned out so far. Currently, we use the convent for meeting space, but once the barn is finished, we will not need the convent for that purpose anymore. It is possible to use the convent for other purposes– a young adult community of single Catholics perhaps. The denial of our recent grant application is a factor to take into consideration here– especially if the funds are not available to renovate and maintain the convent. Over the next several months the parish will need to discern more and more what is best done with the convent.

### Monday June 1: Travel Day

Depart the Historic Conewago Chapel at 8:30am. We will stop for lunch along the way and arrive in Johnstown, NY around 3:00pm. Mass at 5:00pm followed by dinner at Sam's Steakhouse.

### Tuesday June 2: Martyrs' Shrine

Tuesday is devoted to exploration and prayer at the National Shrine of Our Lady of the Martyrs in Auriesville, NY. Tour and Mass in the morning. 


