Enclosed are your child's Aspire test scores from Spring 2017. There is a report on how the entire Prince of Peace Catholic School did as well. It is on the bright yellow sheet.

Dr. Kearney, assistant superintendent, has provided an excellent explanation of why we test and what the results mean. She has also provided a sheet that shows a comparison of how all schools in the Archdiocese of Chicago did as compared to all schools who took the test in nation.

Prince of Peace students did very well on the Aspire assessment with many students scoring in the ready or exceeding categories in regard to the benchmarks established. With few exceptions, Prince of Peace did better than the Archdiocese of Chicago averages and always did better than the national averages. Our instructional planning for this school year will include strategies to strengthen any weak points.

Our faculty has done an excellent job in preparing our students with a high quality education and they continue to strive for excellence. This is exemplified in the assessment results.
