TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 2 Kings 5:14-17

Elisha cures Naaman of leprosy, which convinces
Naaman that there is only one God. Naaman then
asks to take some loads of soil from Israel, so that
he can worship and make sacrifices to one true
God on his own land.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 2:8-13

Paul reminds Timothy that Christ rose from the
dead so that many people could be saved. Paul
was being treated as a criminal and kept in chains
but says, "There is no chaining the word of God!"
Paul also says, "if we die in Christ, we will live in
him. But if we deny him, he will deny us."

Gospel: Luke 17:11-19

Jesus cures ten lepers, but only one returns to
express gratitude for being healed. Jesus is
disappointed that only one gave thanks to God, but
tells that one, "Your faith has been your salvation."

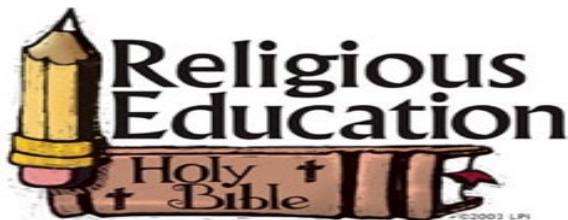
