THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

First Reading: Proverbs 8:22-31

God created Wisdom before he created the earth
or the skies. This spirit stood beside God every day
until the earth was complete, then "found delight in
the people of the earth." This indicates that the
spirit of wisdom was later personified by Jesus.

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-5

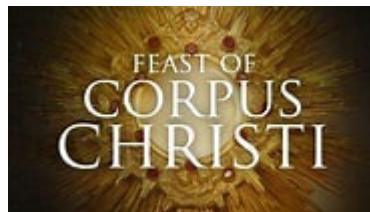

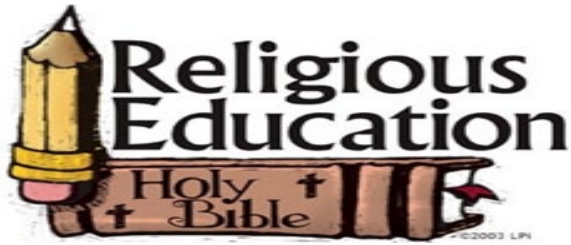

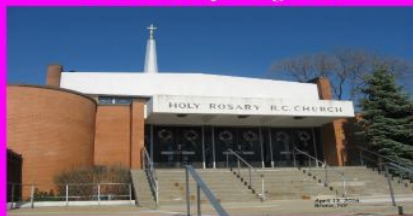

HIS WORD TODAY

The Most Holy Trinity

June 15, 2025

**"Brothers and sisters: Therefore, since we
have been justified by faith, we have peace with
God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through
whom we have gained access by faith in the
grace in which we stand, and we boast in hope
of the glory of God... and hope does not
disappoint, because the love of God has been
poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit
that has been given to us."**

I begin my prayer, blessing myself in the name of the Trinity. I speak of God as my Father, Jesus as my Savior and Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit as the animator and sustainer of my lived faith. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is engrained in my heart. I believe in one God and Three Divine Persons whom I love and who love me. Paul's statement in his letter to the Romans tells me clearly that I have access to God, and I ask that I have access to Him.
