FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

First Reading: 1 Samuel 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a
In seeking a King for the Israelites, Samuel traveled
to Jesse of Bethlehem, who had seven sons.
Commanded by God to ignore the elder sons, Samuel
anointed the youngest, David.

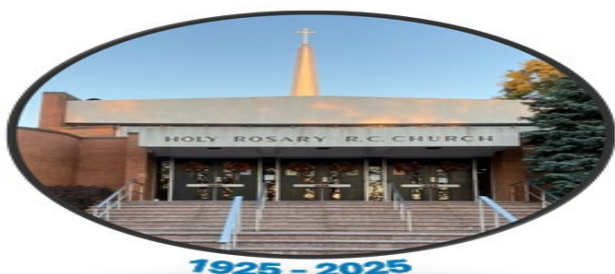

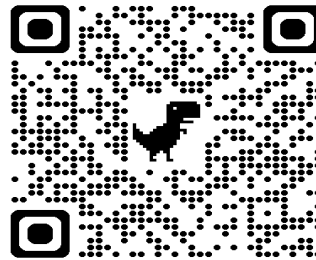
