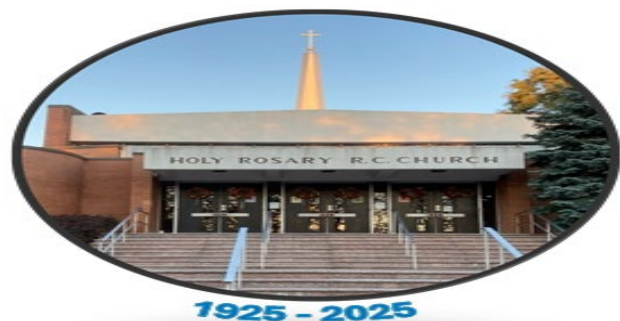

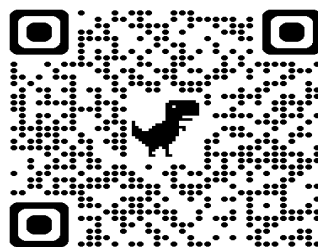
**PLEASE HELP US RESTORE SAFETY AND

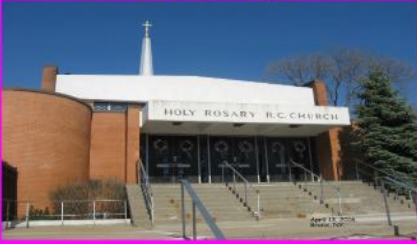
