THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a

A woman in Shunem believed strongly in the holiness of the prophet Elisha. To reward her, Elisha promised that she and her aging husband would, within the year, be the parents of a son.

Second Reading: Romans 6:3-4, 8-11

Paul explains to the Romans that by immersion in water at baptism, they "die" to their sins; by rising from the water, they rise from "death and sin" to new life in Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 10:37-42

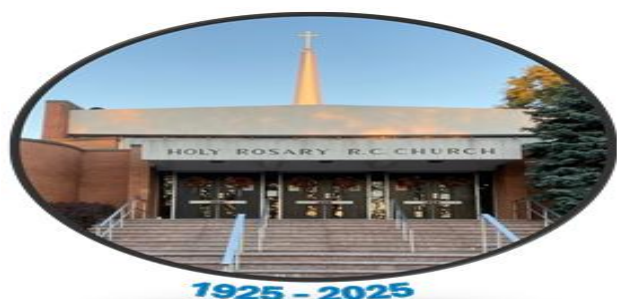

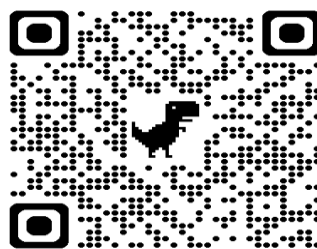
**PLEASE HELP US RESTORE SAFETY AND

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

HIS WORD TODAY

**Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
June 28, 2026**

**"Are you unaware that we who were baptized
into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
We were indeed buried with him through
baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was
raised from the dead by the glory of the Father,
we too might live in the newness of life...we
believe that we shall also live with
him...Consequently, you too must think of
yourselves as dead to sin, and living for God in
Christ Jesus."**

St. Paul gently teaches us something we often take for granted. He asks 'are you unaware' because we sometimes overlook what our baptism really means. We, our parents and godparents, need to make a conscious decision, to avoid spiritual death, so as to live in the newness of life. The church uses the baptismal font as our going down, leaving sinful ways, then rising to a new life, a rebirth in the Lord. Jesus told Nicodemus that we must be born again.

The ritual and ceremony end, but the newness of life is something I need to safeguard and preserve. 'Lord, make me more aware of who I am as a baptized Catholic'. Am I living 'in the newness of life?'
