THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a

Moses reminds the Israelites that when they
were starving in the desert, the Lord fed them
with "manna" -- a food not known to them.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

Paul points out to the Corinthians that through
the sharing of the cup and the breaking of the
bread, they are all one in Christ Jesus.

Gospel: John 6:51-58

After Jesus feeds the five thousand people with
barley loaves and fishes, he tries to make them
understand the significance and the meaning of
what he has done. He tells them, in mysterious
and beautiful words, that the bread he gives is
his flesh and says, "I myself am the living
bread... If anyone eats this bread, he shall live
forever."

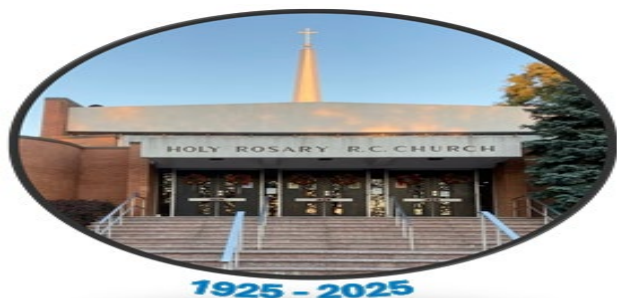

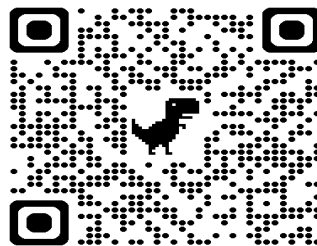
**PLEASE HELP US RESTORE SAFETY AND
