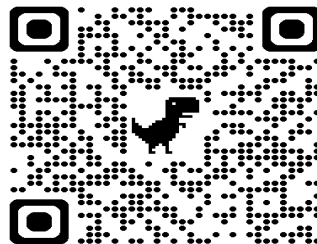
**PLEASE HELP US RESTORE SAFETY AND

pierced side of Christ, and that the

His Blood.*

Calvary and reassumed at His glorious
Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses
through the veins of His risen, glorified,
living body at the right hand of God the
Father in heaven; it is the Blood made
present on our altars by the words of
Consecration; it is the Blood which merited
sanctifying grace for us and through it
washes and beautifies our soul and
inaugurates the beginning of eternal life
in it".*

HIS WORD TODAY

"I say to you... so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth, my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it. Amen I say to you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it and to hear what you hear but did not hear it... But blessed are your eyes for they see and your ears because they hear."

We readily respond to the proclamation of the scripture at mass 'thanks be to God.' However, give it a second thought. Do I realize that I have just listened to my loving God, speaking to me, and expecting a personal response. The word is His message for me at this moment.

Perhaps as I sit to listen to the readings I can quietly ask myself, 'What does the Lord wish to say to me today?'
