Scripture Reflection

In the first reading, the Israelites were winning the battle against Amalek as long as Moses was willing to endure the sacrifice of keeping his hands raised. He needed help and support to keep his hands raised. Sometimes we need support and encouragement to endure our sacrifices.

Paul tells Timothy to remain faithful to what he has learned and to spread the Word of God. Like Timothy, we sometimes need to be reminded what is important in our lives. We must be steadfast in our prayers, be willing to sacrifice for what we believe in, and live our faith by spreading the Gospel message.

Luke tells of a woman who wanted the local judge to make a judgment in her favor. Because the woman was so persistent in her requests the judge, wanting to be rid of her, granted her request. Jesus tells us to persist in our prayers - We are not told that we will get what we want, but that justice and truth will prevail.



Reflexiones de Escrituras

En la primera lectura, los Israelitas estaban ganando la batalla contra Amalec mientras Moisés estuviera dispuesto a aguantar el sacrificio de tener sus manos levantadas. Pablo le dice a Timoteo que tiene que mantenerse fiel a sus enseñanzas difundir la Palabra de Dios. Igual que Timoteo, a veces necesitamos que nos recuerden que es lo importante en nuestras vidas. Tenemos que ser firmes en nuestras oraciones, tenemos que estar dispuestos a sacrificarnos por nuestras creencias, y vivir nuestra fe difundiendo el mensaje del Evangelio.

Lucas nos comparte sobre la mujer que quería que el juez local hiciera un veredicto a favor de ella. Ya que la mujer fue tan insistente con el juez con su pedido, el juez le otorgo su pedido para deshacerse de ella. El mensaje de Jesús es que seamos insistentes en nuestras oraciones. No nos dice que vamos a conseguir lo que queremos, pero que la justicia y la verdad prevalecerán.
