We would like to express our deep gratitude to all of the parishioners who continue to generously support St. John's Food Pantry. We continue to see record numbers of clients and record amounts of donations. Almost 100 more people were served last week than a normal week before the country was shut down. This requires a collaborative effort from our parish as well as several other partners, Good Shepherd Parish, St. Elizabeth Parish, Roanoke Meals on Wheels and Gateway Church in Roanoke. Together we have had sufficient food to serve all of the families who have asked for assistance.

We are excited to share the progress on the new Outreach Building project. A contractor has been selected and the architect is taking the next steps to begin construction.

We see God's hand in the services we provide now and the future plans our parish has to continue this work. It is truly a privilege to be living out the Gospel in such a concrete, tangible way.

- Cash and gift cards can be placed in an envelope with "Food Pantry" noted on the front, and placed in a mail slot near the front doors.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT REMINDER

Renewal deadline August 31, 2020

If you have not attended a Virtus awareness session, Protecting God's Children for Adults, it must be taken **before 08/31/2020**. This deadline applies even if the old Safe Environment course, Safe and Sacred, shows it does not expire until after 08/31/2020. There is no Safe Environment "grace period" for volunteers or employees. **You must always be current with all aspects of Safe Environment in order to volunteer.**

To volunteer, you must:

- Register for and attend an Awareness Session at a location of your choosing every two years. Due to COVID-19, Zoom classes are currently being offered in addition to in-person classes
- Complete a Volunteer Application Packet
- Have a current background check on file
- Have a current driving/credit check on file if you drive or handle money (respectively) for your ministry
- If you are a new volunteer, you will not be able to volunteer until your references have returned the reference letters for you.

Finalización de la nueva sesión de concientización del ambiente seguro **Protegiendo a Los Hijos de Dios Para Adultos** debe ser completada por todos los clérigos, religiosos, empleados laicos y voluntarios antes 1 de septiembre de 2020, independientemente de cuándo hayan completado previamente su certificación de ambiente seguro. **Todos los voluntarios de la escuela, incluso si están al día en su certificación de Ambiente Seguro, deben asistir a una de las nuevas sesiones de Proteger a los Niños de Dios para Adultos antes de ser voluntarios en las escuelas católicas.**

Se tienen que seguir los siguientes Pasos Obligatorios de Ambiente Seguro antes de servir en un ministerio u otro servicio voluntario:

- Completar la Solicitud de Ministerio Voluntario, incluidos los nombres y la información de contacto de 3 referencias (no puede ser un familiar), que serán contactadas.
- Haber firmado el Formulario de Autorización para la Divulgación de Información.
- Que se haya completado la Búsqueda Criminal Nacional, incluida la Verificación de Antecedentes de Delincuentes Sexuales.
- Finalización exitosa del Entrenamiento de Ambiente Seguro.
- Haber firmado el Acuerdo de Código de Conducta, una vez revisado el Código Diocesano de Conducta y Estándares de Conducta para todo el Clero, Religiosos y Ministros Laicos.

Se requiere también un entrenamiento de Participación en un Ambiente Seguro para participar o ser voluntario en actividades o eventos que no están diseñados específicamente para hacer ministerio entre niños o jóvenes, pero para los cuales es razonable pensar que, a veces, podrían tener contacto con niños o jóvenes fuera de la vista o el oído de otros adultos responsables (por ejemplo, debido a tipo de las instalaciones, la ubicación, la hora o por la posible presencia de niños o jóvenes en la proximidad de dichas actividades o eventos).

Incluso, si alguien en el ministerio voluntario no interactúa con niños, ni hay la probabilidad de que interactúe con niños, el Entrenamiento de Ambiente Seguro es extremadamente importante para informar y proteger no sólo a los niños y las personas vulnerables, sino también para proteger a los voluntarios de infringir involuntariamente las políticas.

El Entrenamiento de Ambiente Seguro también alienta y refuerza una cultura de conciencia, y el conocimiento y la vigilancia para proteger a todos dentro de las parroquias, las escuelas y la Diócesis.

Cualquier pregunta o necesidad de aclaración sobre si un ministerio, actividad, evento o servicio voluntario puede requerir el Entrenamiento de Ambiente Seguro se debe dirigir al Director de Ambiente Seguro.

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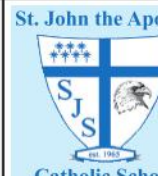
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
