4th Sunday in Ordinary time

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." - Matthew 5:3

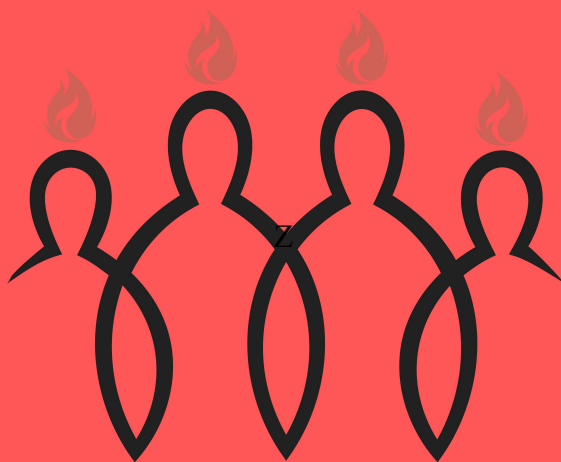

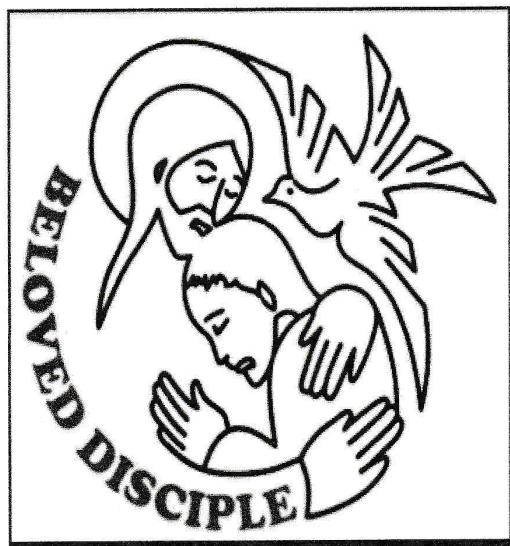
