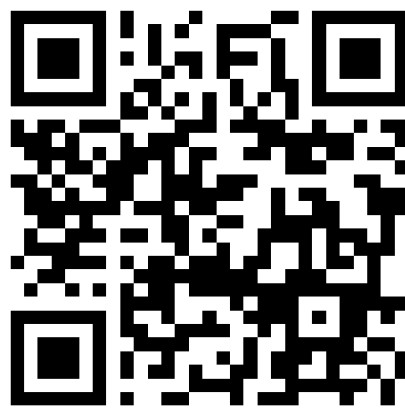

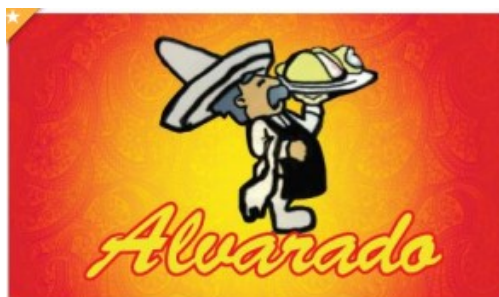
Reflexiones de corresponsabilidad
