

Catechetical Corner

Reception of Holy Communion

It is always good to review so here are some tips when receiving communion.

Before receiving Communion:

- Be in a state of grace (free of mortal sin through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.)
 - Have clean and free hands (pull back sleeve, etc.)Bow before receiving the Eucharist.

Receiving Communion:


In the hand:

- Put one hand on top of the other.
- When the minister says "The Body of Christ", respond with a great Amen.
 - Consume the Eucharist immediately.
- Never grab the Eucharist out of the hand of the minister.

On the tongue:

- You may stand or kneel, either is appropriate.
 - After saying Amen, stick out your tongue outside of your mouth.
- Tilt your head back, and close your eyes (this is so the minister can avoid contact with your tongue.)


