Catechetical Corner | Worthiness

In the last few weeks, I have mentioned a few times about the need to remain seated when you are not receiving communion. I wanted to explain further on the thinking behind this. First, to receive the Eucharist in a state of mortal sin is to profane the Eucharist, which is in and of itself another mortal sin, so definitely do not do that.

Ok, that being said, why not get up and receive a blessing? Well, it comes from the idea that to not receive the Eucharist at the Mass is not something to take lightly. Christ gave us his body and blood so that we may have eternal life, so when we are not in a state of grace, we should want to do everything possible to get back. So, to get up and receive a blessing, while not bad in and of itself, it is possible that we can become okay with not receiving the Eucharist. This should not be the case. We should strive to receive the Eucharist as often as we can because the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith, it is a physical sign of God's love for us, and when we are not able, we should pray even harder and get to confession to be reconciled and then be able to receive him again.

So, to repeat, when you are not able to receive the Eucharist for whatever reason, stay seated, kneel, and pray for God's help that you may be able to receive again, and for everyone else, say a prayer for the person in the pew, so that they may receive Christ, who is love incarnate, again.

En las últimas semanas, he mencionado varias veces sobre la necesidad de permanecer sentado cuando no se está comulgando. Quería explicar más sobre el pensamiento detrás de esto. Primero, recibir la Eucaristía en un estado de pecado mortal es profanar la Eucaristía, lo cual es en sí mismo otro pecado mortal, así que definitivamente no hagas eso.

Bien, dicho esto, ¿por qué no levantarse y recibir una bendición? Bueno, viene de la idea de que no recibir la Eucaristía en la Misa no es algo que deba tomarse a la ligera. Cristo nos dio su cuerpo y su sangre para que tengamos vida eterna, para que cuando no estemos en estado de gracia, queramos hacer todo lo posible para volver. Por lo tanto, para levantarse y recibir una bendición, aunque no es malo en sí mismo, es posible que podamos estar de acuerdo con no recibir la Eucaristía. Este no debería ser el caso. Debemos esforzarnos por recibir la Eucaristía tan a menudo como podamos, porque la Eucaristía es la fuente y la cumbre de nuestra fe, es un signo físico del amor de Dios por nosotros, y cuando no podemos, debemos orar aún más y confesarnos para reconciliarnos y luego poder recibirlo de nuevo.

Así que, para repetir, cuando no puedas recibir la Eucaristía por cualquier razón, quédate sentado, arrodíllate y ora por la ayuda de Dios para que puedas recibir de nuevo, y por todos los demás, reza una oración por la persona que está en el banco, para que pueda recibir de nuevo a Cristo, que es el amor encarnado.






