

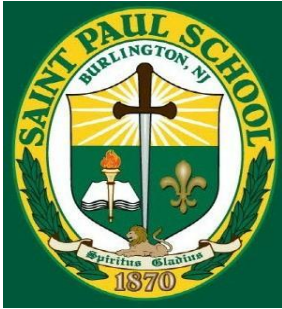

From the Principal

Dear St. Paul School Community:

This Friday is mid-marking period for the second trimester. At this time, student progress will be ready for review. Grades Kindergarten through 2nd grade will be sending **Progress Reports** home to parents and grades 3 through 8 will have **students' up-to-date grades posted in Genesis**. Parents can access Genesis by the end of the school day (January 21) to see student's grade averages in each subject.

This is definitely an opportunity for parents to discuss academic progress with their children. Students need to look at this mid-marking period review as a chance to see if they are happy with the progress in each subject so far, or if necessary, to plan possible strategies for improvement. This is truly **a time for reflection!** This is a time for students to plan for some interventions, if needed. Teachers would absolutely appreciate

conversations with students at this time where improvement can be planned and help provided where and when necessary.

Let's use this as a learning advantage.

Important dates:

1. **Star Renaissance Testing** (Round 2) has begun and will continue through January 28. This standardized assessment is given to all 2nd grade to 8th grade students and will again test Language Arts and Mathematics skills.
2. **Catholic Schools' Week** runs from **January 30 through February 4**. This is the time of year where re-registrations and new registrations for St. Paul School are encouraged and accepted.
