



Fr. Peter McGeory: POLITICS AND RELIGION....

Many Catholics today get upset when the Church and her preachers seem to be getting involved in the world of politics and/or sexual morality. So many will say the pulpit is no place for such topics. So many have taken Cardinal Dolan to task and even our Holy Father Pope Francis when they speak out to defend human life and most recently the fate of immigrants and refugees.

I recently gave a sermon on the defense and sanctity of human life and many people came out of Church clearly unhappy because I very clearly talked about the moral evil that is abortion. I took consolation in the fact that Jesus himself faced the same opposition 2000 years ago when his message of life and social justice were so counter-cultural.

When our politicians enact laws and policies that are a clear threat to the sanctity and defense of human life or when they target the innocent and the most vulnerable, we as preachers and Catholics often MUST speak out. Many would argue that it is a moral imperative. This is not meddling in politics. It is not endorsing any party or candidate, but it is trying to place many of these issues in the context of the values inherent in the Gospel, in the teaching of Jesus, and in the light of our 2000 year tradition.

I recently was appointed to the Board of Trustees of Catholic Charities. I came away from my first Board meeting in awe of what we as a Church here in New York are doing to care for migrants, immigrants, and refugees. I was amazed at what we are doing for the ever-increasing population of the homeless, the addicted, and the mentally challenged roaming our streets. The amount of food we are providing for the hungry and the poor is eyewatering. These are all very concrete things we as a Church are doing. However, we often need to openly confront our legislators whose policies endanger the lives of the unborn or the marginalized.

Cardinal Dolan wrote an editorial in the Daily News on Jan 31. He took lots of heat for it---even from many Catholics. I applaud his moral courage and Christ-like leadership. Like it or not, it goes to the very core of the Gospel message.

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"What we utter is God's wisdom: a mysterious hidden wisdom. God planned it before all ages for our glory. Yet God has revealed this wisdom to us through the Spirit... Jesus said to his disciples: 'I tell you unless your holiness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees you shall not enter the kingdom of God.""

The 'professional' religious people of Jesus' time knew the bible, practiced in detail the requirements of their faith, and most were holy people. They knew the word, lived the word and incorporated it into the daily living.

Fast forward: How does the wisdom of God play out in my life? I know many things from the bible. I can speak about the four gospel writers and enjoy the life of the primitive church as I find it in the Acts of the Apostles. Some passages especially from the letters of Saint Paul, as the hymn of charity or the fruits of the Holy Spirit in Corinthians and Galatians move me.

The wisdom found in the scriptures is to direct my life and focus on just one thing, that is my holiness. Knowledge in the head must move down a few inches and become the life giving pump for my heart. Holiness too is a gift of God for me to seek, discover and accept. We call Jesus 'the holy one of God' and we are to be as well.




