

BAPTISM PREPARATION



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The NEW required registration form for the 2017-2018 program is available on our website <u>www.saintjosephreligiouseducation.org</u>

The registration form must be completed in full. Students are not automatically registered. You must re-register your child for next year. Spaces are limited and based on a first come first served basis.

Incoming First Grade Parents: Children who are entering first grade in September need to register for Religious Education. Regarding Letters of Sponsorship for Baptism and Confirmation

We receive many requests for "Letters of Sponsorship". Many of the requests come from people who have little or no association with St. Joseph's Parish. In order for us to honestly testify to your good standing as a parishioner, these are the basic requirements:

- One must be an active parishioner of St Joseph's for at least 6
 months. This means: one must be registered here and you MUST be
 attending Mass. Being an 'active' parishioner also means you are
 committed to some form of stewardship of your time, talent and
 financial resources to help support the parish and the Church of the
 Archdiocese of New York.
- You MUST have received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation yourself.
- If married, you must be in a Catholic Church recognized marriage.

If these minimum requirements are not fulfilled, it is **NOT** possible for any of the priests to endorse your sponsorship for the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation.

HIS WORD TODAY: A fresh perspective on the Sunday Readings - By Rev. William J. Reilly

"Beloved: We did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of Our Lord Jesus Christ, but we had been eyewitnesses of his majesty... We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain."

Jesus selected the three apostles, allowing them to catch a glimpse of His divinity. The scene – a mountain, where God met Moses, where Jesus gave the beatitudes in His sermon, provides the backdrop for this special revelation.

The voice, echoing the words spoken at the Jordan at His baptism, reveals the special relationship of Jesus with the Father. Peter is witness to it all.

'This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased.' May the words spoken on this occasion be a mantra for us, reflecting God's care and love for us. We are His beloved and He is pleased as we strive to live our Christian lives. And like the three, may we open our eyes and see no one but Jesus.


