*Fr. Peter McGeory:* PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION FOR THE HOLY LAND — Each year on Good Friday, an offering is received for the Pontifical Good Friday Collection for the Holy Land. This collection was scheduled at the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion on Friday, April 10. The COVID-19 pandemic precluded the normal community celebration of Holy Week. Since the Christian communities in the Holy Land are

living in contexts already full of serious suffering, Pope Francis has approved the proposal that, for this year 2020, this collection take place on Sunday, September 13, near the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, including the anticipated Mass on Saturday evening.

#### **CARDINAL'S APPEAL UPDATE 2020**

The Cardinal's Appeal has been going now for about 30 years.

Each year, the Appeal raises much-needed funds to support poor parishes, seminarians, our retired priests, and to do out-reach programs to young and old alike. Here at St Joseph's, we have had a proud record of not only making our targeted goal but exceeding it! So many of our parishioners are wonderful examples of what it means to be good stewards.

Our parish goal this year is \$362K. Right now, we are at about 80% of that goal with about \$287K pledged. This extraordinary generosity is from just 410 families---just 16% of our entire parish. We need about \$75K more to meet our goal. Our prayer is that so many families who have never been involved in the Appeal in the past will become involved this year.

I know the past 5 months have been financially challenging for many. Believe me, our parish has suffered some substantial financial losses. However, there are so many in our backyard in the Archdiocese who are in serious need and rely on our generosity. The need has never been greater than now.

Please consider making a pledge to the Appeal. Your gift—large or small—will make a huge difference in the lives of so many who are far less fortunate than we are.

#### Regarding Letters of Sponsorship for Baptism and Confirmation

We receive many requests for "Letters of Sponsorship". Many of the requests come from people who have little or no association with St. Joseph's Parish.

In order for us to honestly testify to your good standing as a parishioner, these are the basic requirements:

- One must be an active parishioner of St Joseph's for at least 6 months. This means: one must be registered here and you MUST be attending Mass. Being an 'active' parishioner also means you are committed to some form of stewardship of your time, talent and financial resources to help support the parish and the Church of the Archdiocese of New York.
- You MUST have received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation yourself.
- If married, you must be in a Catholic Church recognized marriage.

If these minimum requirements are not fulfilled, it is **NOT** possible for any of the priests to endorse your sponsorship for the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation.

#### **Sunday Reflection**

Last week, Jesus called Peter the "rock". This week, Jesus calls him a tempter and tells him to leave.

The contrast between these two episodes can be explained through the cross. The cross is easily the most challenging truth about the Christian faith.

The cross shows us the gravity of sin. It displays clearly what sin can do to people. Sin destroys people.

Likewise, Jesus tells us that the cross is a sign of sacrificial love. Married couples love each other in this way. People in the religious life promise to love the lord and the church in this way. As Christians we too are called to love one another like this. Our love should resemble the love on the cross.

Jesus also teaches us that the cross is the only way to eternal life, and that there is no other way, no other short cuts to Heaven.


Like Peter we too very often try to avoid the cross. This is the work of the evil one, and this is the reason why, in this Sunday's gospel, Jesus rebukes Peter and says, "get behind me Satan".

Therefore, especially in times of difficulties, sickness, loneliness, and so on, let us listen to Jesus saying, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me."



#### Dear friends in the Lord:

The COVID-19 pandemic concerned many countries and in several of them, preventive measures precluded the normal community celebration of Holy Week. The Christian communities in the Holy Land, also exposed to the risk of contagion and living in contexts already full of serious sufferings, benefit every hear from the generosity of the faithful from all over the world.
