Regarding Letters of Sponsorship for Baptism and Confirmation

We receive many requests for "Letters of Sponsorship". Many of the requests come from people who have little or no association with St. Joseph's Parish.

In order for us to honestly testify to your good standing as a parishioner, these are the basic requirements:

- One must be an active parishioner of St Joseph's for at least 6 months. This means: one must be registered here and you MUST be attending Mass. Being an 'active' parishioner also means you are committed to some form of stewardship of your time, talent and financial resources to help support the parish and the Church of the Archdiocese of New York.
- You MUST have received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation yourself.
- If married, you must be in a Catholic Church recognized marriage.

If these minimum requirements are not fulfilled, it is **NOT** possible for any of the priests to endorse your sponsorship for the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation.


Reflection for this week: Epiphany of Our Lord: Did your star lead you to find the Lord in your journey of faith?

The magi or the three kings set on a journey from a faroff land to see the new-born king. It was the star that triggered their desire to meet the new-born king. They had a goal. To attain the goal, they have to face a lot of obstacles and uncertainties -- hazardous journey, attack from robbers, uncertainty of length and time of their journey, etc. Yet they made the choice and proceeded.

As they guessed, they encountered many challenges. One such was that the star that guided them, disappeared. They try to ask for help. They came to the sneaky Herod. Though he helped, yet had a cunning motive in his request to revisit him. Finally, overcoming every obstacle, they met and worshipped the King Jesus. They attained their heart's desire. They achieved the end of their pursuit. It was not one-way traffic. The Lord also guided them and showed Himself to them.

The magi's journey portrays the journey of every individual soul in its pursuit of God. There is a "Godshaped hole" in every person, a void in his soul that can only be filled by God. It is similar to what St. Augustine has said in his Confessions, "Our hearts are made for thee, O Lord, they do not rest, unless they rest in thee." The relentless pursuit begins early in life. There are monks and religious whose whole pursuit in life is God. There are many lay people who amidst their busy family life, focus their attention to attain God. They face obstacles, overcome them and still they pursue.

The beauty in this pursuit is that it is not we who pursue God, on the other hand, it is God who equally pursues us; He is the starter, helps us to overcome obstacles and steer the course to attain our final goal of life, namely, the beatific vision, either here on earth or in heaven.

HIS WORD TODAY: A Fresh Perspective On The Sunday Readings - By Rev. William J. Reilly

"After Jesus' birth in Bethlehem of Judea during the reign of King Herod, astrologers from the east arrived one day in Jerusalem inquiring: 'Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We observed his star at its rising and have come to do him homage.'... they were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house, found the child with Mary, his mother."

The visitors were looking for Jesus. They brought gifts portraying His role as priest, prophet and king. They depended on a star to lead them to their Savior.

The Magi event is so familiar, found in scripture, filled with traditions. Their search ended with a great discovery and blessing. In the gospels the question is asked, 'what are you looking for?' or 'who is it that you seek?'

We are like the wise men, looking for the Lord. Where can we find Him? Right here, right now. Jesus makes Himself known to us, if we bring the gift of ourselves, if we wish to pay Him homage. It requires humility, honesty and sincerity as we recognize Him as savior of all humankind.


