

#### THOUGHTS FROM THIS LAST WEEK

A WORD

This last week, the Church has celebrated 3 very important feasts. Each one has something for us to consider.

August 4<sup>th</sup> was the Feast of St John Vianney. He is better known as The Cure (Parish Priest) of Ars in France. He is the patron Saint for all parish priests. He struggled to get through the seminary, but once ordained, he became a compassionate confessor sought many from all over Europe. He would hear confessions from 11-16 hours a day. His picture outside our confessionals here at St Joseph's is there for a reason. John Vianney reminds us all of the need for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. His feast day reminds us all to pray for and to encourage vocations. In an age of closing and merging parishes, we are in desperate need of priests.

August 5<sup>th</sup> was the Feast of St Mary Major one of the 4 great basilicas in Rome. It is the oldest Church in the western world dedicated to Mary. This great church goes back to the Council of Ephesus in 431, when Mary was formally declared "The God-bearer," the "Mother of God." This feast reminds us of our need to wisely seek the intercession of Mary OUR Mother in an age when she has been sorely neglected.

August 6<sup>th</sup> was the Feast of the Transfiguration. We remember how Jesus took Peter, James, and John up a high mountain to be changed in their sight. They not only heard the voice of God but they also saw a vision of Moses and Elijah---the 2 great prophets of the Old Testament. This feast is not really about Jesus changing. It is about the change Jesus wanted to happen in his Apostles and the change He hopes will happen in you and in me.

In these hot and humid days of August, the Church celebrates 3 very meaningful feasts:

- --To pray for priests and to reflect on the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- --To seek the help of Mary our mother and never to neglect her.
- --To allow the grace of Jesus to change us all in order to be closer to Him.



HIS WORD TODAY: A Fresh Perspective On The Sunday Readings - By Rev. William J. Reilly


"He lay down and fell asleep under the broom tree, but then an angel touched him and ordered him to get up and eat. Elijah looked and there at his head was a hearth cake and a jug of water... but the angel of the Lord came back a second time, touched him, and ordered, 'Get up and eat, or else the journey will be too long for you.' He got up, ate and drank, then strengthened by that food, walked forty days and forty nights to the mountain of God, Horeb...' 'I am the bread of life.'"

The scriptures have been focusing on the 6<sup>th</sup> chapter of John, asking us to appreciate more deeply the feeding the Lord did for His people and continues for us today.

The seeming miraculous feeding of Elijah shows God's care, His hand, and the response of the prophet to the messenger of the Lord. He needed that food to sustain him and continue his prophetic work.

Jesus, in His concern for the crowd fed them and told His disciples to give the people something to eat. They were hungry. We are true disciples for the Lord and ask that the tremendous gift of the Eucharist, so available for us, may we eagerly seek and not just presume.

How many parishes are without priests today to provide the Eucharist. How many of us who have attended mass virtually are yearning to receive holy communion? As Elijah looked and found the food God provided for his journey, may we renew our desire for and seek Him in the Eucharist.


