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

La Riqueza de la Generosidad de Dios

Cuando entendemos la generosidad de Dios, nos damos cuenta de lo ricos que realmente somos. Incluso si tenemos poco dinero en el banco, nuestras vidas son ricas en Dios --- sintiéndonos protegidos y cuidados por Él, quien nos da abundancia de paz para poder transitar a través de las pruebas y batallas con sabiduría y fortaleza.

La generosidad de Dios también conduce a los bienes materiales. Toda bendición material que tenemos viene de Dios. Él nos la entrega a través de los talentos y habilidades que Él mismo nos ha dado. Lo que ganamos a través de nuestros propios esfuerzos proviene originalmente de los esfuerzos de Dios. Dios es la fuente de todo lo que es bueno en nuestras vidas.

Sin embargo, siempre hay un propósito que es más grande que nosotros, todo lo que viene de Dios está destinado a beneficiar a otros también. Somos los canales de la generosidad de Dios.

Cualquier cosa que tengamos y que nos negamos a compartir se convierte en causa de pecado. Sucumbimos al egoísmo, que es similar a la codicia. El problema con la codicia es que perjudica a otros, negándoles lo que Dios quiere compartir con ellos.

¿Qué nos hace vulnerables a este pecado? La autosuficiencia. Viene de pensar que podemos confiar solamente en nosotros mismos y en nuestros propios recursos en lugar de asociarnos con Dios en generosidad. Aun cuando reconocemos que Dios ha sido generoso con nosotros, la autosuficiencia dice que somos responsables de prevenir la pobreza por dar a otros.

Cuando protegemos nuestras vidas mediante el almacenamiento de bienes, otros sufren. En la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús resalta ambas cosas, la codicia y la autosuficiencia, ya que son completamente contrarias a la personalidad de Dios.

La generosidad crece cuando entendemos que Dios es el proveedor de todo lo bueno y que seguirá proveyéndonos incluso cuando regalamos a otros lo que Él nos da a nosotros -- y *especialmente* cuando damos lo que Él nos da. Piensa en lo tienes en abundancia (ya sea dinero, gozo, sabiduría, lecciones aprendidas por la experiencia o...). Ahora mira a tu alrededor. ¿Cómo podrías ser tú la respuesta a las oraciones de alguna otra persona?

Cualquier cosa que esperamos tener ya pertenece a Dios y está destinada a ser compartida con otros. Este es el principal principio económico del reino de Dios. El Cuerpo de Cristo sólo prospera cuando hay un continuo intercambio de bienes, a esto le llamamos la comunión de los santos.

Preguntas para la Reflexión Personal:

¿Qué es lo más difícil de compartir o regalar para ti? ¿Por qué te aferras a ello? ¿Qué temes que ocurrirá si lo regalas?

The Wealth of God's Generosity

When we understand God's generosity, we realize how wealthy we truly are. Even if we have little money in the bank, our lives are rich in God -- feeling protected and cared for by God, giving us an abundance of peace that gets us through trials and battles with wisdom and endurance.

God's generosity also leads to material goods. Every material blessing we have comes from God. He delivers it to us through the talents and skills that he has given to us. Whatever we earn through our own efforts comes originally from God's efforts. God is the source of everything that's good in our lives.

However, there's always a purpose that's bigger than us. Everything from God is meant to bless others, too. We are channels of God's generosity.

Whatever we have that we refuse to share becomes the cause of sin. We succumb to selfishness, which is akin to greed. The problem with greed is that it hurts others by denying them what God wants to share with them.

What makes us vulnerable to this sin? Self-reliance. It comes from thinking that we can rely solely on ourselves and on our own resources instead of partnering with God in generosity. Even when we recognize that God has been generous with us, self-reliance says that we are responsible for preventing the poverty of giving it away to others.

When we protect our lives by storing up our goods, others suffer. In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus addresses both greed and self-reliance, because they are completely contrary to the personality of God.

Generosity grows when we understand that God is the provider of everything good and that he will continue to provide for us even when we give away what he gives to us -- *especially* when we give away what he gives to us. Think about what you have in abundance (be it money, or joy, or wisdom, or lessons learned from experience, or ___). Now look around. How might you be the answer to someone else's' prayers?

Whatever we hope to have already belongs to God and is meant to be shared with others. This is the primary economic principle of the kingdom of God. The Body of Christ thrives only when there's a continual exchange of goods. We call this the communion of saints.

Questions for Personal Reflection:

What is most difficult for you to share or give away? Why do you cling to it? What are you afraid will happen if you let go of it?

¿Qué conexión hay entre el cáliz de la Misa y la sepultura de Jesús?

Cada elemento del cáliz tiene un simbolismo profundo, que lo vincula con la Pasión, la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús así todo lo empleado en la Misa católica tiene una honda historia detrás con varios niveles de simbolismo. Un ejemplo son el cáliz y la patena que se usan durante la Misa para poner el pan y el vino eucarísticos que se transforman en cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad de Jesucristo.

Concretamente, el cáliz y todos los elementos en torno a él se conectan simbólicamente con la muerte y el enterramiento de Jesús, recordando al sacerdote la Pasión y Resurrección de Jesús cada vez que celebra Misa. Parte de este simbolismo, de hecho, se hace explícita en la consagración tradicional del cáliz y la patena, cuando un obispo o sacerdote recitan antiguas oraciones sobre los objetos sagrados para prepararlos para la liturgia.

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What connection is there between the chalice of the Mass and the burial of Jesus?

Each element of the chalice has a deep symbolism, which links it to the Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus so everything used in the Catholic Mass has a deep history behind with several levels of symbolism. An example is the chalice and paten used during Mass to put the Eucharistic bread and wine that are transformed into the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ.

Specifically, the chalice and all the elements around it are connected symbolically with the death and burial of Jesus, reminding the priest of the Passion and Resurrection of Jesus every time he celebrates Mass. Part of this symbolism, in fact, is made explicit in the traditional consecration of the chalice and the paten, when a bishop or priest recites ancient prayers on the sacred objects to prepare them for the liturgy.


