This ACTS retreat allows men to focus on their faith and its application in daily life, to build purpose in prayer life, to increase their presence at the liturgy, and to cultivate friendships with others who share our faith.

The retreat begins on a Thursday evening, with check-in at the Saint Paul Parish Center. You are encouraged to bring family members or friends to see you off. Transportation will be provided to and from the Saint Raphael Retreat Center, 901 South Madison Avenue, Dallas TX 75208.

The weekend concludes on Sunday at the 11:00 a.m. Mass at Saint Paul the Apostle. Immediately following the Mass, retreatants will share refreshments and fellowship in the parish center with their families and other members of the parish community.

A Spiritual Companion will be available throughout the retreat.

All denominations are welcomed. Retreatants must be 21 years or older.

The cost for each retreatant is \$300. This covers all meals and lodging. A registration deposit of \$100 must be submitted with this form to reserve your place. Purpose of ACTS

ACTS is an acronym for **A**doration, **C**ommunity, **T**heology and **S**ervice. The purpose of an ACTS weekend is to provide an opportunity for retreatants to develop a deeper relationship with the Lord and fellow retreatants through **A**doration and daily prayer; through **C**ommunity within one's faith community as a member of the Body of Christ; through **T**heology [the teachings of our Catholic faith] by encouraging more study, and to instill a virtue of **S**ervice to our Lord, our parish and each other.

The Message of ACTS

ACTS is inspired by the ACTS of the Apostles 2:42-47:

They devoted themselves to the teachings of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of bread and to prayers. Awe came upon everyone and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. All who believed were together and had all things in common: they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need. Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals in exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And, every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.

What happens on an ACTS Retreat?

Talks and activities during the retreat focus on Adoration, Community, Theology and Service, from which the ACTS program acronym is derived. Holy Scripture and the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church are the guides for the retreats.
