Women's Guild 2025-2026

Guild by the Numbers – 2025-26

Evangelization in the Community at Large

- Hosted 6 Funeral Receptions and a Diocesan Senior Gathering.
- Made, prayed over and gifted 12 Prayer Blankets
- Served 250+ people at 3 Network of Community Ministry Lunches.
- Served 150+ college students at two UT Student Center Sunday Dinners
- Served drinks, breakfast and lunch to Richardson Area Habitat for Humanities workers twice
- Delivered hundreds of handmade newborn beanies to Parkland
- Delivered 750+ Meals to Meals on Wheels recipients.
- Raised over \$2,200 for White Rose, \$600 for St. Vincent de Paul, 55 Christmas gifts for Meals on Wheels clients, and countless in-kind donations to food banks and other charities

Guild by the Numbers – 2025-26

Within our Parish

- Tidied pews, replaced missalettes and votive candles, watered plants, decorated for holidays, laundered linens and robes routinely
- Supported Father's Ordination Anniversary celebration, Men's Club Appreciation Dinner, Paulapalooza, and Army Alumni Dinners
- Raised over \$16,000 - by dues, games, donations, fundraisers (exceeded income budget by \$3K)
- Used 80% of our budget for charitable and spiritual causes.
- Donated over \$15K to parish and school.
- Worked approx. 2,500 manhours by our membership = nearly \$18K at minimum wage!
- Prayed at least a hour a week before the Blessed Sacrament.
- Served 200 donuts and 80 cups of coffee at two Donut Sundays

Guild by the Numbers – 2025-26

Fun and games

- With awesome hostesses, fed, entertained and informed an average of 50 women each month. This is the equivalent of 10 small wedding receptions!
- Had a wonderful communion mass, breakfast and speaker in January
- 18 Regular Bridge Players (3 subs) played monthly. Judy has chaired Bridge since 2003! Sandra joined her as co-chair in 2008. This year she passes on the baton to Jackie Tracy
- Taught 15 new players this year, added an evening group. Almost 55 players signed up, enough for 2 tables on average Fridays or Tuesdays.
- 8 new players joined Bunco this year bringing the total to 48 players
