INTRODUCING: Father Joe Campbell

I was born in 1991 and raised in Superior Township (near Ann Arbor) in a big house tucked away in the woods of our 38 acres of land on a quiet dirt road. I am the second youngest of a family of 10 –7 boys and 3 girls. Two of my brothers have been married since the late 90s, and one of my sisters married 5 years ago. My other two sisters are Dominican sisters—one with the Sisters of Mary Mother of the Eucharist in Ann Arbor and the other with the St. Mary Sisters in Bismarck, North Dakota. I have 20 nieces and nephews and 4 great nieces and nephews. We were by no means farmers, but when I was growing up we always had lots of pets around the house and ample amounts of time in the woods in our back yard all year long.

I wanted to become a priest from a very young age. Though I tried to ignore this call to the priesthood while in high school, after graduating I entered seminary—somewhat begrudgingly. Though entering seminary was challenging, I immediately experienced such a profound peace that I knew I was where God wanted me to be. God gently worked on my heart over the years and after much prayer and formation, I found a strong desire for the priesthood growing in me. There were some bumps along the way, but ultimately after 8 years of seminary—four in Minnesota at St. John Vianney College Seminary and four in Detroit at Sacred Heart Major Seminary—by the grace of God I was ordained a priest on June 10th, 2017.

My first assignment was as the Parochial Vicar (associate pastor) at St. Patrick Parish in Brighton. I served there for four years and got my first real taste of parish ministry as a priest. I had a great experience at St. Patrick. It will always hold a special place in my heart as my first parish assignment. In July of 2021, I left St Patrick and started a new assignment as the full-time chaplain at Lansing Catholic High School. I just finished my first year there and I am loving it. It is such a joy and a privilege to be with the students and help form them into disciples of Jesus.

About a month ago, Bishop Boyea called and asked me to start helping out with Sunday Masses in Fowler and Westphalia in addition to my chaplain role. I gladly accepted the request and am looking forward to serving in your community. I've spent some time in the area over the years and love the strong Catholic culture. I'm so excited to get connected with all the families at Most Holy Trinity and St. Mary's. I'm also happy to have a more stable parish connection on the weekends. For the last year, I have had Sundays open and would go around all over the Lansing area helping cover Masses where needed. It's been hard to build real connections with parishes this way, so I'm happy to have a consistent weekend assignment every Sunday.

Please pray for me in my priestly ministry. I look forward to meeting you all in the weeks and months to come.

Important: Do Not Sign Pro-Abortion Petitions

There is a petition in Michigan circulating right now called the *Right to Reproductive Freedom (AKA Reproductive Freedom) Initiative*. This petition seeks to make abortion at all stages a Constitutional Right in the State of Michigan. It only needs 450,000 signatures by July 11th to appear on the ballot this November (2022). Once in the Constitution, abortion will be in Michigan forever. It is very important that you understand this because the language of the petition is very deceptive. Bishop Boyea and the other Michigan bishops are all opposing this petition, with Bishop Boyea stating that signing this petition places one "in danger of grave or mortal sin."


