- * Please call the parish office (989)587-4201 or stop in during business hours. **We do not schedule Masses through email or voicemail.**
- * We can schedule one year out from the date we are contacted. We do not go beyond a year so if someone passes away they have that date for their 1 year anniversary. At this time we are only able to schedule 1 Mass per intention a year.
- * Those scheduling wedding anniversaries, 50, 55, 60, 65 years or more are encouraged to schedule their Mass as far ahead as possible and will not be held to the 1 year restriction.
