RCIA Rite of Acceptance & Rite of Welcome

The Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens is for inquirers in the RCIA process who are preparing for their Baptism. They are now ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward becoming Catholics. At this Rite, they are asked to more fully embrace the Gospel message with the help of God, and are also signed with the Cross to show that they now belong to Christ, the Shepherd of souls. In this Rite, the parish community has the opportunity to more fully participate in and pray for those in the RCIA process. This Rite places these catechumens in a formal relationship with the universal Church. This year we have 2 children who will join the Order of Catechumens: Oliver Borodychuk and Declan Gleason.

The **Rite of Welcoming** is for inquirers who have been previously baptized and are ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. At this Rite, they are asked if they are ready to listen to the apostles' instruction, gather with the worshiping community in prayer, and join that community in the love and service of others. They are signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ. This year we welcome Chad & Lisa Borodychuk and Randi Gleason.

The Rite of Acceptance & Rite of Welcome will be celebrated this **Sunday, January 7th at the 10:00 AM Mass**. Let us rejoice with our Catechumens and those seeking Full Communion with the Catholic Church as they take this next step in their formation.

Marian Devotions

On First Saturdays beginning on January 6th through May, we will be reflecting on all 20 mysteries of the Rosary through the Five First Saturday Devotions. This devotion was asked of each of us by Mary and our Lord surrounding the events at Fatima. God's will is to establish in the world devotion to Mary's Immaculate Heart. Mary promised special graces for those who follow this devotion. Devotions will begin at 8:15 AM in the church (come in person or join anytime via our parish Facebook livestream) and will last around 45 minutes.

Requirements: on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, one shall confess (+/- 20 days), receive Holy Communion (Sunday obligation is acceptable), recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep Mary company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary (both will be fulfilled for those who attend), all with the intention of making reparation for the sins of blasphemy and ingratitude committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Mary, you know the practices of this devotion will lead us closer to your Son and bring conversion and peace in our hearts, our homes, and ultimately to the world.
