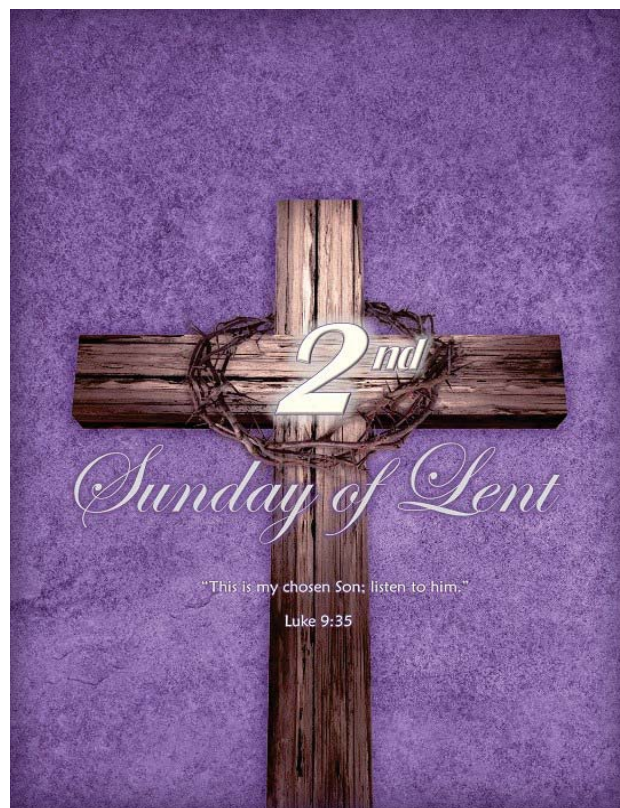

### From Your Pastor

In today's first reading Abraham, our father in faith, encounters God's great promises of having descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and the grains of sand on the seashore. Both are so expansive that Abraham can neither grasp them all nor count them. These promises are delivered with a ritual of smoke and flame as Abraham agrees to take a journey with God that will last for the rest of his life. This year in our parishes and dioceses throughout the world we are invited by Pope Francis to journey together in his calling for a worldwide synod on synodality. This process invites the Church through consultative assemblies, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, to pray, listen, analyze, dialog, discern and offer advice on making pastoral decisions which reflect God's will as closely as possible. As we are called to embrace this synodal path of the Synod 2021-2023, the following prayer invites the Holy Spirit to operate within us so that we may be a community and a people of grace.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit,  
as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us,  
make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go  
and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful;  
do not let us promote disorder.

#### **Why the Ancient Traditions of Prayer, Fasting & Almsgiving during Lent?**

In preparation for the great celebration of Easter, we are called to pray, fast and give alms as some of the ways to help us draw closer to God during Lent.

Prayer is one of the ways to connect with God, in silence, in words, and in worship. Jesus prayed constantly and taught us to pray to Our Father in heaven. Jesus emphasized that our prayer need not be long, complicated or showy, but rather, short, to the point, and heartfelt.

Fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, (taking only one full meal) reminds us of our dependence on God. We "do not live on bread alone."

On the Fridays of Lent we remember the sacrifice of Christ on Good Friday and unite ourselves with that sacrifice through abstinence from meat. These are acts of self-discipline and self-control which can help to keep us mindful of God's loving presence.

Almsgiving: Lent invites us to see the face of Christ in the hungry and homeless, sick and suffering. Jesus depends on us to listen with compassion to the joys and sorrows of our friends and family members and to reach out in kindness and compassion to all.
