

#### From Your Pastor

Next weekend we will be conducting our annual collection for the diocesan Partners in Charity appeal. We are joining with the other parishes in our diocese in making this appeal during the Lenten season. Many of you will have already received letters from both Bishop McManus and me about this appeal. In past years you have been very generous to this appeal, having exceeded our parish's goal. Our goal for this year is the same as it has been for the past two years -\$100.00. I am sure that we can have another successful year in meeting this year's appeal. As in the past, we would like to reach our goal by June 1st. Please be as generous as you can in helping to meet the needs of our Diocese of Worcester.

Once again, I am extending an invitation to the young men of our parishes who are in high school or older to consider a vocation to the priesthood. As a priest for almost 43 years, I know that I would not have considered this calling if it were not for the example of priesthood that I saw lived out faithfully and prayerfully by the priests in my home parish. I certainly witnessed in these priests an excellent example of what was meant by giving of oneself totally to God. Their giftedness and self-sacrifice were certainly a great inspiration for me. For any young man who has ever considered the priesthood, please feel free to speak with me or Fr. Charles. I might also mention that our diocese annually sponsors a retreat, led by Bishop McManus, for young men to discern or prayerfully consider if the priesthood is for them. This year's retreat is scheduled for the weekend of April 7/8, from 6:00 P.M Friday to 6:00 P.M. Saturday at Immaculate Conception Retreat Center in Putnam, CT. (This retreat center is only 30 minutes from Worcester.) It is open to men who are of high school age and older. The cost is free, and transportation is also provided to and from the retreat center. ## Dispensation from Abstinence on Friday, March 17

This year the Liturgical Memorial of St. Patrick, March 17, falls on a Friday of the Second Week of Lent, a day of abstinence. In light of the number of inquiries about my granting a dispensation from the requirement to refrain from eating meat on the Fridays of Lent, I am granting a diocesan-wide dispensation from the law of abstinence on Friday, March 17, 2017. I would ask the Catholic faithful who take advantage of this general dispensation to perform another act of penance on either the day before or after March 17, 2017.

Stop by our church hall after Mass and buy a Hope for Housing caring card. You receive the full face value of the card in the amount you choose. The stores - CVS, Panera Bread, Dunkin Donuts and local grocery stores - donate up to 5% of that amount to "Hope For Housing" to assist the most vulnerable; children with families in crisis.





Since Matt passed away in November of 2016 we have sold \$17,410 worth of "caring cards" here at St. George. That means that in less than three months \$870.50 has been donated to Hope for Housing to help prevent homelessness. At this rate, our parish is on track to donate more than \$2,500 this year!

If several more St. George families begin to use "caring cards" to buy their weekly groceries, we might be able to help even more families to move from a shelter to a new home.

At the IHN shelter we have seen the faces of the children in these families and we know the stress that life in a shelter puts on parents and the little ones. Please pray for them and continue to be as generous as you always are
