2nd Sunday of Advent

In a writing course, students had to write an essay in which they were to define love. It proved to be a difficult challenge. Everyone had used the word, and knew what it referred to. But to actually define it, make it precise and understandable, took a lot of time and effort. Most of the students did not do well. They knew what it meant, but had difficulty explaining it. It raises a good question for us in Advent. What do we really believe? We use religious words like faith, belief, grace and salvation, Savior and Lord. But what do the words mean to us? How do they change our way of looking at the world, and how we act and what we think?

Time and time again, the Church calls us to be renewed, to strengthen our faith, to deepen our prayer, to be more apostolic and to offer a better example to others. Our faith is meant to be one of action, change, and transformation. During Advent, we recall God's plan of salvation, and how we are the beneficiaries and the missionaries of His work and love. We know the whole story of our redemption. With God's presence -His grace— in our lives, we are changed. Our celebration and our actions will tell the world how.

Non-perishable food items, donated here at St. George parish reach those in need throughout the city

Throughout the year and especially during the holiday season, the community of St. George donates bags, boxes and carloads of food for folks in need. We are sometimes asked, "where does all this food go." Here are some of the places that receive and help distribute the food to those in need:

St. Joan of Arc and Our Lady of Providence are Catholic Parishes on Lincoln Street in Worcester. Their food pantries help to provide weekly supplemental groceries to elderly residents living on fixed incomes who live in near-by high rise buildings. They also serve working families who need assistance to help make ends meet especially during times of sickness or family crisis.

The "Loaves and Fishes" food pantry serves neighbors in our local zip codes. The food is distributed from the UUC on Shore Drive. This pantry is an interfaith effort supported by several churches on Brattle Street. It began decades ago at St. John's Episcopal Church which shared a "covenant relationship" with St. George Parish. More than 70 families are served once a month.

The **Mustard Seed** food pantry serves 30 + families and 20+ individuals once a week. A small bag or box with about 15 staple items are given to each person from the Piedmont St. neighborhood. This area includes housing for those with a variety of life challenges and several homeless folks or those living in shelters.


