As we are all experiencing this crazy time in our lives with work closings, social distancing and our places of worship only now gradually beginning to reopen, we have had to adapt to a new way of experiencing life for the time being.

With that being said, a few of us at Saint George have offered our services to be neighborhood ambassadors to represent our parish of Saint George in distributing the weekly bulletin. Since late March I along with the help of my children have been distributing 15-20 weekly bulletins in the Birchwood neighborhood in Holden where our family lives. I think we are all experiencing a more community feeling as we are confined to our homes, and I have found this to be even more evident as I walk through our own neighborhood each week distributing the Bulletin.




